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**Narrative**

Incident: Overdose

On 07-15-2018 at approximately 1900 hrs, I responded to the bus stop in front of Delilah's Den on Rt 9, for an Overdose call. Upon our arrival, a female, later identified as [REDACTED] was observed unconscious sitting on the bench in front of the bus stop mentioned above.

I approached [REDACTED] and went to feel for a pulse. At this time, she awoke. I asked [REDACTED] where she was coming from. [REDACTED] advised that she just ended a shift at Delilah's Den. While speaking to Ms. [REDACTED] I detected an odor of alcoholic beverages emanating from her breath. Her eyes also appeared bloodshot, pinpoint, and her speech was slurred. She was also having difficulty staying awake. I asked [REDACTED] if she consumed any narcotics and/or alcohol. [REDACTED] advised that she consumed her prescribed Xanax and some cocaine. She advised that she also consumed alcohol.

I advised [REDACTED] that since she overdosed, she was going to be transported to CMC. She advised that she understood. She was then transported without incident and voluntarily to CMC by TRPD EMTs. No further action taken at this time.
