Narrative

Toms River Police Department Investigation Narrative

On 7/19/18 at 1924, the undersigned responded to Rite Aid at 220 Route 70 in reference to a heroin overdose. Upon arrival, the subject [REDACTED] was observed sitting in the driver seat of a blue 2009 Ford Escape (NJ registration D20JSL) unresponsive. One used hypodermic syringe was observed on the passenger seat. [REDACTED] regained consciousness after being given one dose of Narcan by EMS on scene. He was then transported to Kimball for further treatment via ambulance.

Upon arrival at Kimball, [REDACTED] was taken into custody on the strength of an outstanding Jackson warrant (W424361325). Jackson PD arrived at the hospital and assumed custody for processing. The used syringe was placed into a sharps container for destruction. The vehicle's keys were turned over to the registered owner, [REDACTED]
