On 7/19/18 at 1924, the undersigned responded to Rite Aid at 220 Route
70 in reference to a heroin overdose. Upon arrival, the subject
was observed sitting in the driver seat of a blue 2009 Ford Escape (NJ
registration D20JSL) unresponsive. One used hypodermic syringe was observed on
the passenger seat.

regained consciousness after being given one dose
of Narcan by EMS on scene. He was then transported to Kimball for further
treatment via ambulance.

Upon arrival at Kimball, was taken into custody on the strength of an outstanding Jackson warrant (W424361325). Jackson PD arrived at the hospital and assumed custody for processing. The used syringe was placed into a sharps container for destruction. The vehicle's keys were turned over to the registered owner,
