On 7/21/18 at approximately 2135 hours, Ptl. Elwood #406 and I responded to the McDonald's, located at 1786 Hooper Ave, in reference to a possible overdose. Ptl. Elwood was first on scene and advised that the male, later identified as [REDACTED] had agonal breathing but had a strong pulse. Shortly after, I arrived on scene and came into contact with the above listed involved person, [REDACTED] who stated that [REDACTED] may have been drinking and taking sleeping pills. [REDACTED] stated she did not see [REDACTED] take anything but he has done opiates in the past. [REDACTED] did not have any reason to believe that [REDACTED] was depressed or suicidal. During this time, Sgt. Mooney #335 arrived on scene.

Toms River Med Unit and MONOC Paramedics then arrived in which TR Med Unit administered narkan to [REDACTED]. He was then loaded into the ambulance for transportation. While EMS personnel were working on [REDACTED] he started to come to and became semi-responsive. TR Med Unit and MONOC then transported [REDACTED] to Community Medical Center for further treatment.

Located on the floor beneath the rear passenger side seat where [REDACTED] was sitting was (1) wax fold of suspect heroin stamped "HELLCAT" in black ink. The evidence was seized and logged into evidence locker #2 at District One to be destroyed. No further police action.
