On 2/16/18 at approximately 1607 hours, I responded to Boscovs located in the Ocean County Mall, 1201 Hooper Ave, in reference to an overdose. Upon arrival to the location, I came into contact with the above listed victim, who was alert and conscious.

then stated that she has been taking a mood stabilizer, Trileptal, for the past couple weeks. Her initial dosage was 150 mg, but was recently increased to 300 mg per day. She stated that her dropped off her prescription medication in a plastic bag and accidentally provided her with 600 mg of the Trileptal. stated that approximately 20 minutes prior, she accidentally took the 600 mg of the Trileptal instead of taking the 300 mg because she thought she was provided a single dosage. was shivering and experiencing shortness of breath.

Toms River Medical Unit responded and assessed was then transported to Community Medical Center for further evaluation by the Medical Unit. No evidence recovered at the scene as it was consumed by No further police action.
