On 2/16/18 at approximately 1607 hours, I responded to Boscovs located in the Ocean County Mall, 1201 Hooper Ave, in reference to an overdose. Upon arrival to the location, I came into contact with the above listed victim, [REDACTED] who was alert and conscious.

[REDACTED] then stated that she has been taking a mood stabilizer, Trileptal, for the past couple weeks. Her initial dosage was 150 mg, but was recently increased to 300 mg per day. She stated that her [REDACTED] dropped off her prescription medication in a plastic bag and accidentally provided her with 600 mg of the Trileptal. [REDACTED] stated that approximately 20 minutes prior, she accidentally took the 600 mg of the Trileptal instead of taking the 300 mg because she thought she was provided a single dosage. [REDACTED] was shivering and experiencing shortness of breath.

Toms River Medical Unit responded and assessed [REDACTED] was then transported to Community Medical Center for further evaluation by the Medical Unit. No evidence recovered at the scene as it was consumed by [REDACTED]. No further police action.
