Narrative

Toms River Police Department Investigation Narrative

On Saturday May 26, 2018 at approximately 1956 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] Shenandoah Boulevard on the report of an alleged violation of a restraining order. Upon arrival, I met with the reporting person, [REDACTED] who advised me that at approximately 1715 hours, he believed the suspect, [REDACTED] violated a court ordered amended final restraining order.

The investigation revealed that on July 27, 2016, [REDACTED] was issued an amended final restraining order against [REDACTED] ordered by Judge Doran J.S.C. [REDACTED] informed me that he believed [REDACTED] violated the restraining order by contacting his children's baby-sitter, [REDACTED] and his daughter, [REDACTED] while they were shopping at the Ocean County Mall.

I then spoke with [REDACTED] who advised me that at approximately 1715 hours, she and [REDACTED] as well as other juvenile children, were shopping in Charlotte Russe, located in the Ocean County Mall. [REDACTED] reported that while inside the store, an unknown female shouted [REDACTED] which [REDACTED] then looked at the female. [REDACTED] stated that the female advised [REDACTED] that "someone will buy her anything in the store that she wanted". [REDACTED] advised me that when she questioned the female in reference to this statement, the female stated "someone out there will buy you anything in the store you want". [REDACTED] reported that she and [REDACTED] declined the female's offer then began to leave the store. [REDACTED] informed me that as they were leaving the store, she observed the female engaged in conversation with [REDACTED] who at that time was also standing inside Charlotte Russe. [REDACTED] reported that they continued to exit the store, at which time, [REDACTED] and the other female began taking photographs of them. [REDACTED] informed me that they left without further incident.

[REDACTED] was advised of his NJ Domestic Violence Victim's Rights. He did not wish to speak with members of the Domestic Violence Response Team.
