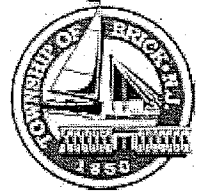

On June 20th, 2018 at approximately 2151hrs Ptl Valeri #244, Ptl Stephenson #278 and I were dispatched to the [redacted] for a suspected overdose. Upon arrival we observed a white male wearing a tie-dye shirt on the ground near the tree line who appeared impaired. The male was later identified as [redacted]. Brick EMS arrived on scene and immediately began evaluating [redacted] for a possible overdose. [redacted] displayed signs of opiate use and had trouble speaking and relaying information to EMS.

We spoke with the caller, [redacted], who stated that he and [redacted] were near the tree line as they were about to go for a bike ride. [redacted] stated that [redacted] came to his house and was in his sight the whole time. [redacted] then stated they went to his van near the bike trail where [redacted] went into the back while [redacted] stayed in the front passenger seat. [redacted] was only in the back of the van for a few minutes while [redacted] was left unattended.

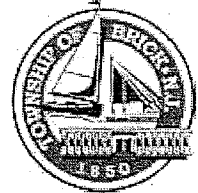
When [redacted] and [redacted] were about to begin their bike ride [redacted] had fallen over and became unresponsive and showed signs of overdose. It was not until our arrival that [redacted] was regaining consciousness. [redacted] stated that [redacted] had both a history of drug use and brain trauma. Detective Mauro #207 and Detective Alvarado #221 responded to the scene and were notified of my findings.

In the ambulance [redacted] became more alert and advised medical staff that he had snorted one bag of heroin prior to overdosing. [redacted] was still unable to provide much of his biographical information or where he got the heroin from. [redacted] was then transported to Ocean Medical Center for further treatment. While on scene, [redacted] suspected [redacted] snorted the heroin while he was in the back of the van preparing for the bike ride. [redacted] stated he never saw [redacted] ingest the heroin. Outside the vehicle on the ground of the passenger side door I located a white wax fold with no stamp or identifiers. The wax fold was placed into evidence.

[redacted] was released without incident. [redacted] was treated at Ocean Medical and expected to recover.

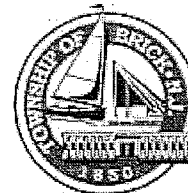

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On 06/20/18 at 1313 hrs Ptl. Feeney #200 and I responded to [redacted] in reference to a subject who had attempted suicide. Dispatch advised that the subject was being treated by her nephew, [redacted], who is a member of the Brick Police EMS Squad.

Upon my arrival I was met outside by [redacted] advised me that his aunt, [redacted] has been suffering from depression for a long time. Furthermore, she has attempted suicide in the past as well. He stated he was called by sister, [redacted], and advised of the incident. He explained to me that he wrapped both wounds which consisted of a superficial laceration on her right wrist and a little bit deeper cut on her left wrist; however she did not hit the artery. He also advised that she took some pills.

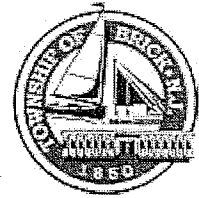
We then entered the residence where we were met by [redacted] and her family. [redacted] advised she has been depressed lately because her mother has been in and out of the hospital. She stated the medicine does not seem to be working and she has not been sleeping very well today. [redacted] explained to me she woke up this morning around 0800 hrs and took a handful of pills (Vistaril-used to for anxiety). While speaking to her, [redacted] counted her pills and believed that she possibly ingested 37 pills since 0800 hrs. [redacted] explained to me she took the pills because she just wanted to sleep; however at some point she brought the knife back in her room and slit her wrists while laying in bed.

Ptl. Feeney arrived on scene and began speaking with [redacted]. She advised him she was outside on the porch when their mother gestured for her to come in and check on [redacted]. When she went in, she observed the blood on the sheets and when she pulled back the covers, she observed the knife lying on the bed next to her. [redacted] told her, "I don't want to live anymore." She immediately applied towels to the wounds and called [redacted] or help.

First Aid arrived on scene and subsequently transported [redacted] to the hospital for further treatment. It should be noted that the knife used was one of a set of kitchen knives and was left at the scene in the care of the family.

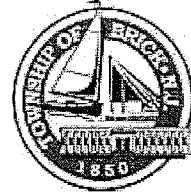

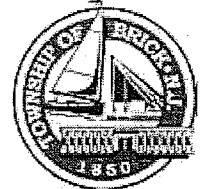

On 06-13-2018 at 2232hrs Sgt. Hine #158, Ptl. Finelli #273, Ptl. Bennett #279, Ptl. Riccio #289, and I Ptl. Bailey #293 responded to in reference to an overdose. Dispatch advised that it was an active overdose.

Upon our arrival, Ptl. Riccio was already on scene along with Brick EMS. Upon entering the house, I was met by the caller, identified as [redacted], who pointed us in the direction of the bathroom. I then went into the bathroom where the male, identified as [redacted] was unconscious on the floor. Brick EMS administered the first dose of NARCAN at 2240hrs. Upon receiving the first dose [redacted] began to regain consciousness. I was advised by Ptl. Riccio that several hypodermic syringes and several empty wax folds containing suspected heroin residue were located in the bathroom near [redacted]

While speaking to [redacted], she stated [redacted] had been to rehab and been clean for some time. [redacted] stated she had not been down to room for some time and did not know what was down there. [redacted] advised [redacted] left the residence earlier with a friend, identified as [redacted], to go to the Point Pleasant Beach inlet. Upon arrival back at the residence, [redacted] stated [redacted] and [redacted] went downstairs into [redacted] room where they stayed for a short amount of time. [redacted] advised [redacted] then came upstairs to use the bathroom. Approximately ten minutes later, [redacted] stated she banged on the bathroom door with no answer, so she forced the door open finding [redacted] unconscious.

After speaking with [redacted] Ptl. Bennett and I went down into [redacted] room while EMS and Ptl. Riccio stayed with [redacted] While in his room we observed more syringes, and numerous white wax paper folds in numerous locations in plain view. Some of the folds had red skull markings and the words "NO PAIN" written on them.

[redacted] regained consciousness several minutes after being administered the Narcan. As a result, all the above contraband was collected and removed from the residence so it could later be logged into property for destruction.

After speaking with [redacted] I spoke with [redacted] about tonight's incident. [redacted] stated that he texted [redacted] earlier saying he needed some company because he felt like he may relapse. [redacted] advised that the two previously met while at rehab, and they try to keep each other clean. [redacted] advised he was also a recovering cocaine addict. [redacted] stated that after picking [redacted] up in his vehicle, they drove to Speedway gas station before heading to the Point Pleasant Beach inlet. While in Speedway, [redacted] stated he split up from [redacted] for a minute or so to buy a black and mild cigar, then leaving to his car without [redacted] He stated [redacted] went to buy a drink, but [redacted] came back to the car with nothing from inside the store. They then proceeded to the inlet, where they talked and stayed for an hour. [redacted] stated while at the inlet [redacted] was only with him and no one else. The two later returned home to residence where [redacted] stated he went down stairs to [redacted] room and [redacted] went into the bathroom. [redacted] advised it was dark down there so he did not see any of the wax paper folds or syringes. [redacted] stated he went upstairs once he heard [redacted] screaming.

[redacted] did not appear to be under the influence of any drugs, and stated that his drug of choice used to be cocaine. He advised that [redacted] may have met up with someone in the short time they split up at the Speedway gas station, but that would have been the only time and [redacted] never said anything about picking up any drugs. [redacted] further advised that he believes the heroin must have already been in [redacted] residence prior to him picking [redacted] up.

[redacted] was transported by ambulance to Brick Hospital without incident. Ptl. Bennett and I then responded to police headquarters where the seized contraband was logged into property for destruction. DSgt. Petrola of the Drug Enforcement Unit was notified of the incident.

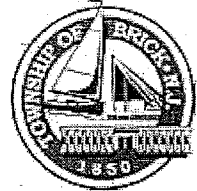

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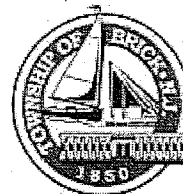

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On June 11, 2018 at approximately 0605 hours Ptl. DeMaio #194, Ptl. Byers #226, and Ptl. Gannio #234 were dispatched to for a report of an overdose. Ptl. Nye #245 and I responded as well to assist.

Upon my arrival Brick Police EMS was already on scene, had administered a dose of Narcan, and were actively performing life saving measures. Monoc paramedics arrived on scene as well to assist. Ptl. Byers advised me that when he arrived the suspect/victim who overdosed was and that he was found lying face down, unresponsive in the downstairs bathroom. Ptl. Byers was able to move from the bathroom to the dining area and turn him over and start life saving measures. When Brick Police EMS took over Ptl. Byers searched the bathroom and found two used hypodermic syringes, a bundle of unused suspected heroin, one empty bag of suspected heroin, all stamped with "pepsi" in red ink, and a blue and black pocket knife believed to be used to cut the heroin, located on the counter top near the sink. Ptl. Byers secured all evidence and turned it over to me on scene.

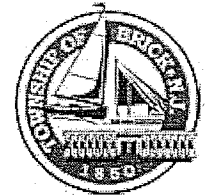
While on scene Paramedics an EMS were able to revive while I spoke with mother and his sister stated that was recently released from , a rehab center and that she thought he was no longer using drugs. explained that just prior to the time she called 911 she observed the bathroom light on and the bathroom door was locked. called out to and tried to make contact with him through the door but was unsuccessful. afraid something was wrong, utilized a screwdriver to gain access into the bathroom, finding unconscious in the manner described above. told at this time to call 911. While on scene I explained to the Blue Hart program and provided her with a magnet to place on her refrigerator for when was released from the hospital.

I responded to Ocean Medical Center where I spoke with who continually was questioning what was going on and where he was. I explained to what had happened and he stated he does not use heroin and he does not know how he got it. I contacted Det. Sgt. Petrolla #201 of the Brick Police Drug Enforcement Unit and advised him of the incident. Sgt. Petrolla advised there was not going to be a response from DEU officers at this time and that it was not necessary that I remained at the hospital with I explained to the Blue Hart program and that I left the refrigerator magnet with his mother and he was turned over to medical staff without incident.

I then responded to Police Headquarters where all evidence was logged and placed in an evidence locker to be destroyed as per policy.

Upon arrival, Officers were met at the front door by [redacted] and [redacted] advised that his niece, [redacted] was in the master bedroom and had just used heroin. I entered the master bedroom. Near the bathroom vanity, sitting in a crouched position, I located [redacted] was breathing in a slow manner, but was responsive to verbal commands. [redacted] advised that she originally found [redacted] laying on her back, and she placed her on her side in the recovery position. [redacted] stated that she believed that [redacted] had used Heroin approximately four minutes prior to Police being contacted.

While on scene, [redacted] was alert and able to hold a conversation. [redacted] stated that she had purchased Heroin from an unknown source between 0000 and 0300 hours, today. [redacted] stated that she administered Heroin to herself, via hypodermic needle, in her left arm while in the bathroom, and flushed the wax paper that it came in. The needle was located on the bathroom vanity. I retrieved the needle and placed it into a proper sharps container. The needle was placed into Property via Departmental Guidelines.

Brick Police E.M.S. arrived on location and attempted to render medical attention to [redacted] refused medical attention. She stated to me that she used heroin to help her sleep. [redacted] stated that she has previously spoken to a sergeant within Brick Police in reference to the Blue Hart Program. [redacted] stated further that she was going to attend an Intensive Outpatient Program (I.O.P.), in order to aid her in overcoming her addiction.

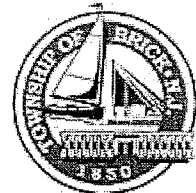

According to [redacted] he was unaware if [redacted] took any type of CDS.

[redacted] advised of the following events. She was sleeping when [redacted] woke her up stating [redacted] was unconscious. Both she and [redacted] attempted to give [redacted] CPR until police arrival. [redacted] has had problems battling addiction to CDS in the past.

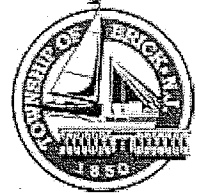

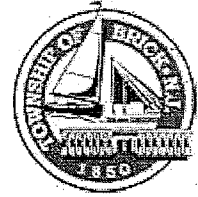

On arrival I spoke to \_\_\_\_\_ who stated that his friend, later identified as \_\_\_\_\_, was passed out in his vehicle. Brick Police EMS M534 and I were able to wake \_\_\_\_\_ with a sternum rub. Brick EMS 5314 and Monoc Medic 205 also responded to the scene.

Brick Police EMS advised me that while examining \_\_\_\_\_ they found a napkin with numerous wax folds wrapped in bundles which is indicative of heroin in plain view in her right front pocket. I took possession of the napkin and placed it into an evidence bag.

There are five bundles with approximately ten wax folds in each bundle with a stamp that says "LET'S Go." There were another two bundles with approximately ten wax folds with a stamp that says "BEST BUY." There was one bundle of wax folds that is wrapped in a magazine page that I was unable to view.

I spoke with \_\_\_\_\_ and asked what had happened. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that \_\_\_\_\_ contacted him and asked if he would pick her up from the Dunkin Donuts (469 Herbertsville Rd) because she was homeless. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that he picked her up from the Dunkin Donuts and she did not seem right. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that by the time he brought her back to the house she was passed out. \_\_\_\_\_ believes that Dippel received the heroin from Asbury Park, NJ.

All of the wax folds were placed into property and Sgt. Rivaldo contacted Sgt. Petrola #201 of the Drug Enforcement Unit to notify him of the incident.

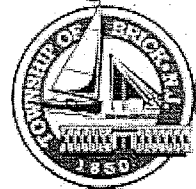

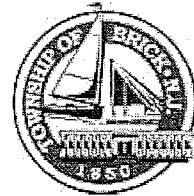

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On 6/07/2018 at 0753 hours, Ptl. Koch #170 and I responded to the Ocean Monmouth Care at [redacted] in reference to a 911 call for a possible overdose. Upon our arrival we spoke to the nursing supervisor, [redacted]. Nurse [redacted] told us that a counselor in the facility had advised her that a patient ([redacted]) was hallucinating and acting in a bizarre manner.

Nurse [redacted] escorted us to [redacted] and we attempted to speak to her about the incident. At this time the Brick Police EMS had responded and we entered an empty room, next to the main lobby. We spoke to [redacted] and observed that she was having medical distress. We observed that she could barely stand and she swayed as she attempted to stand still. Her eyes were bloodshot, pupils were dilated and she could not speak without slurry and losing her train of thought. Nurse [redacted] advised us that [redacted]

[redacted] had admitted to her staff that she took several medications and illegal drugs this morning. She told them that she used two bags of heroin and took Xanax, muscle relaxers, smoked marijuana, and used a catnip cocktail. She stated that her counselor watched as [redacted] had picked something out of her nose and she questioned what she was doing. She stated that [redacted] replied that she had snorted the catnip and referred to it as catnip salt.

Due to the patient's condition, she needed to be immediately transported to the Brick ER for further medical assistance. At this time, Nurse [redacted] handed me a pocket book that belonged to [redacted]. She stated that the patient was attempting to pull a large, zip lock container from her pocket book as we entered the lobby. Nurse [redacted] stated that she opened the zip lock container and observed that it contained 3 pill boxes and a small amount of marijuana. The nurse was concerned that [redacted] had taken too much of the prescription medication and she realized that none of the prescription bottles were in the patient's name. She handed me the opened zip lock container and that prescriptions were inventoried and the hospital staff was later advised. Prior to my departure, Nurse [redacted] advised me that [redacted] made several statements about her mental health. She stated that the patient stated that she has nothing to live for and that it would be a change for the better if she was gone.

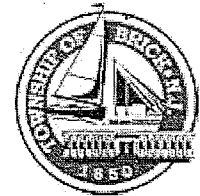
The patient was then transported to Brick ER and the staff was advised of the incident. The hospital staff advised me that the patient would be medically cleared then seen by a member of the Crisis Unit. The patient was left in the care of the hospital and the above items were seized and later placed into property.

The Drug Enforcement Unit was contacted and advised of the incident. It should be noted that the first prescription container was prescribed to [redacted] from [redacted]. This contained 8 blue, circular pills that had 031 inscribed on them and 16 blue, oval pills that had G8258 inscribed on them, which could possibly be Alprazolam. The prescription container was for Oxycodone HCL 30 Mg Tab issued by [redacted]. The second prescription container was prescribed to [redacted]

from [redacted]. This contained an unknown crushed and broken pill. The prescription was for Amphetamine Salts. The third prescription container contained 4 unknown capsules that appeared to be handmade, 2 white pills with 2410 inscribed, 1 white pill with APO TI-4 inscribed, and one pink, unknown pill. The zip lock container held a green vegetation, suspected to be marijuana.

K9 Officer Sgt. Catalina #229 then arrived on location in attempt to locate [REDACTED] with his K9 partner Duke. During the search [REDACTED] approached Sgt. Catalina while he was in front of the residence. Brick Medical Unit #534 transported [REDACTED] to the Ocean Medical Center hospital to be treated for his suspect consumption of prescription medication. Ptl. Bennett #279 rode in the ambulance and I followed in my patrol vehicle. At the hospital [REDACTED] was turned over to hospital staff without incident.
