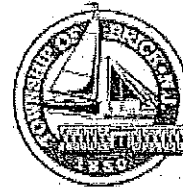

On 07/24/2018 at 1926hrs Ptl. Foley #247 and I responded to [redacted] for a report of an unconscious male who was possibly experiencing agonal breathing. Upon arrival, I was met outside by the caller [redacted] advised that his father was just inside the door on the living room floor. I entered the residence and located [redacted] lying on his back with his eyes and mouth open. [redacted] appeared to be experiencing agonal breathing, and his eyes were slightly glassy and pin point. I checked for, and was able to locate a pulse in his carotid artery. Just as I located a pulse, EMS personnel arrived on location and began working on [redacted]. As they were doing so, I spoke with [redacted].

In speaking with [redacted] he advised that he was sitting at the dining room table playing a game with his two nieces [redacted] when he suddenly heard what sounded like snoring. [redacted] stated he told [redacted] to go and check on [redacted] because he was knew he was in the other room. After walking away briefly, [redacted] came running back and advised that [redacted] was on the floor in his current state. This is when [redacted] called for assistance.

In speaking with [redacted] further, he advised that he was unaware of any narcotics [redacted] may have taken. He stated [redacted] arrived home from work around 1630hrs, and had been walking around the house and doing things in the backyard before he ended up in the living room on the floor. He further stated that [redacted] overdosed on an unknown narcotic back in January of this year. He stated EMS were called to the residence and were able to administer narkan and revive [redacted] during that incident.

EMS administered several doses of narkan, and were able to revive [redacted]. He then began moving his legs and breathing normally on his own. I checked the residence for any signs of narcotics or drug paraphernalia. I checked the living room, [redacted] bedroom, all three bathrooms, and the back yard area where he was seen. I also checked the interior of [redacted] vehicle. No narcotics or contraband of any kind were located. [redacted] was transported to Kimball Hospital in Lakewood so he could be monitored. [redacted] mother [redacted] arrived home from the library as the ambulance was leaving. I advised her of the incident and informed her of what hospital [redacted] was being taken to.

On 7/30/18 at approximately 2130 hrs. Ptl. Barlowski #284 and I responded to [redacted] in reference to a report of an overdose. Upon arrival Ptl. Barlowski #284 observed the subject, later identified as [redacted] on the ground in front of the residence. See Ptl. Barlowski #284 report for further details.

While Brick Police EMS treated [redacted], I spoke with the caller, [redacted]. She stated that [redacted] was her boyfriend and that he just used Heroin. She stated they were just picked up from the IHOP in Brick by a friend, [redacted], and went back to his residence at [redacted]. She advised that once at the residence [redacted] went inside and used the bathroom. Once he came out, he sat on a couch in the garage and slumped over. [redacted] stated that she immediately called 911 and assumed he just overdosed on Heroin.

After speaking with [redacted], I spoke with [redacted]. He stated that he and his friend, [redacted], picked up [redacted] and his girlfriend [redacted] from the IHOP in Brick. He stated that all four went back to [redacted] to watch television. Once at the residence he stated that he went inside to advise his girlfriend, [redacted] that he was home. He stated that she was just getting out of the shower and was currently in the bathroom. After speaking with [redacted] stated he went into the garage to meet up with the other three and noticed [redacted] unconscious on the couch. He advised that it appeared as though [redacted] was not breathing at which time he began to perform CPR. While [redacted] called 911, he advised that he carried [redacted] from the couch inside the garage out onto the street directly in front of the driveway. He stated that he thought it would be easier for first aid to treat him at the end of the driveway instead having to walk in between all the vehicles that were parked.

Once I finished talking to [redacted] I spoke with [redacted] and her father [redacted]. They both stated that they were inside the residence and did not realize the other four subjects were in the garage. [redacted] stated that she became aware of the incident after [redacted] came inside and told her that he was home. She stated that she came out of the bathroom and heard the commotion inside the garage and realized that [redacted] overdosed. [redacted] advised that he was not aware anybody was home until the police and first aid responded.

After speaking with both [redacted] and [redacted] I spoke with [redacted]. He advised that he and [redacted] picked up [redacted] from the IHOP in Brick. He stated that they then drove directly to [redacted] where [redacted] and [redacted] all entered the garage. [redacted] advised that he stayed outside in the driveway and made a phone call. He stated that while he was on the phone he heard yelling from inside the garage. When he entered the garage he observed [redacted] performing CPR on [redacted]. He stated that he observed [redacted] carry [redacted] from the garage and out onto the street so that first aid could get to him faster.

Prior to [redacted] being transported to Ocean Medical Center, I attempted to speak with him. I asked him what happened as well as what he just ingested. [redacted] refused to answer any of my questions at the time of this report. While attempting to speak with him, I observed a bundle of four white wax folds, held together by a rubber band, on the ground, directly next to where [redacted] was found. The four white wax folds each contained a white powder inside of them. The wax folds were taken and placed into property at headquarters.

Detective Nixon #209 was contacted and advised of the incident. [redacted] was transported by Brick Police EMS to Ocean Medical Center for further medical treatment.

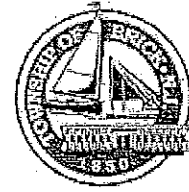
On 07/30/2018 at 2132 hours Ptl. Prendeville #223 and I were dispatched to [redacted] in reference to an overdose. Upon arrival I was met by [redacted] who stated that the unconscious suspect was in the garage to the rear of the residence.

As I turned the corner there was yelling coming from [redacted] directly behind the house in question. I observed a subject, later identified as [redacted] performing chest compressions on [redacted]. I immediately responded and provided the subject with a 4mg dose of Narcan to the right nostril. I then applied the AED pads. After analyzing was complete I continued chest compressions until Brick Township EMS 534 responded a short time later.

Once the rig responded life saving measures were turned over to them. [redacted] regained consciousness a few minutes later and was transported. See Ptl. Prendeville's report, filed under the same case number, for more information.

On 7-28-18, at approximately 0600 hours, Ptl. Stevenson #278 and I responded to 425 Jack Martin Blvd (Brick ER) in reference to an overdose.

Upon arrival I spoke with [redacted] stated she arrived at the hospital with her friend [redacted] at approximately 0526 hours. Her friend [redacted] registered with Brick ER Staff. Hospital records indicate complaint was "vag problem." While both females were waiting to be seen by hospital staff, [redacted] and [redacted] entered the public bathroom. During the time in the bathroom, both [redacted] and [redacted] began using heroin from the same syringe. [redacted] then had a negative reaction to the heroin and began seizing in the bathroom stall. [redacted] realizing her friend was overdosing called for hospital staff.

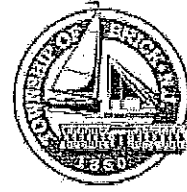
Hospital staff removed [redacted] from the bathroom and brought her to room 14. While in the room hospital staff administered Narcan. Once Narcan started working, [redacted] regained consciousness. At this time [redacted] fled from the hospital and left the area with an unknown subject.

The syringe was located in the bathroom stall garbage and was properly discarded. No used or unused bags of heroin were located in the bathroom. The only other information [redacted] provided, was that she injected the heroin in her hand and it was a white bag with a green stamp.

Due to the nature of the call, DEU was contacted and advised they would not be responding.

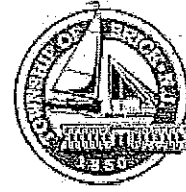
On July 26th, 2018 Ptl. Mesmer #292 and I were dispatched to \_\_\_\_\_ in reference to a suspected overdose. Ptl. Oliverio #286 and Ptl. Riccio #289 also responded to assist. Ptl. Mesmer arrived on scene first and BTPD EMS 534 arrived moments later. Upon arrival we observed a white female laying on the first bedroom floor unresponsive. The victim was identified as \_\_\_\_\_ had shallow agnail breathing and pin point pupils. Next to the bed was a nightstand that had one syringe without a cap.

EMT Spiedel and Sweeney administered one dose of narcan. Moments later \_\_\_\_\_ began to awaken and become responsive. \_\_\_\_\_ was loaded onto the stretcher and subsequently transported to Ocean Medical Center for further evaluation. Located in \_\_\_\_\_ purse was approximately 5 empty wax folds in her wallet. There was no identifying stamps only skulls. She was turned over to emergency staff without incident.

All wax folds were submitted as evidence in accordance with departmental policy. The single syringe was destroyed by OMC staff. Detective Mauro #207 of BTPD's Drug Enforcement Unit was notified and advised he would not be responding at this time.

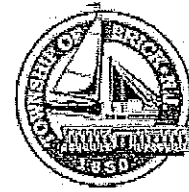

On 07-18-2018 at 2110hrs. Ptl. Mulcahey # 130, Ptl. Fogarty # 211 and I were dispatched to [redacted] for a 33 yr. old female unconscious unresponsive. While en-route to the residence dispatch advised us a resident had narcan and was administered to the victim.

Upon our arrival we met with the female victim [redacted] and she was alert and conscious. [redacted] stated she snorted one bag of heroin in the bathroom and walked out to the back deck to have a seat. She said that was the last thing she remembered.

Also on the back deck was [redacted] stated he left the residence earlier and when he returned found [redacted] unconscious on the back deck. He and several other roommates attempted to wake her and were unsuccessful. [redacted] stated he had received a dose of Narcan at a class he had taken a while back. [redacted] went into the residence to retrieve it and returned to give [redacted] the 4mg dose of narcan. [redacted] regain conscious a short time later.

[redacted] was subsequently transported by first aid to Brick Hospital. Det. Mauro # 207 was contacted and met me at the hospital to speak to [redacted]. Ptl. Fogarty found four clear empty wax folds on top of the victims purse at the residence. The wax folds had a purple skull imprinted on them with the words "The Punisher" printed on the bottom. They were collected and placed into property as per department policy and procedure.

On 7/8/18 at 1234 hours Sgt Cook #140, Ptl. Geskey #184 and I responded to \_\_\_\_\_ in reference to an overdose. The caller, who wished to remain anonymous, stated a 22yr old male subject was unconscious and not breathing.

Upon arrival I observed \_\_\_\_\_ a known CDS user, pouring glasses of water on an unconscious male subject who was laying on the ground. I recognized the unconscious male subject as \_\_\_\_\_ was unresponsive and was displaying agonal breathing. Beside \_\_\_\_\_ was an orange capped syringe. I asked \_\_\_\_\_ what happened. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that \_\_\_\_\_ called him to come over and hang out and when he arrived he found him on the floor unconscious. \_\_\_\_\_ advised he thought pouring water on him would help wake him up.

I administered 1 4mg dose of Narcan to \_\_\_\_\_. When I stood up after administering the Narcan, \_\_\_\_\_ was no longer on location. As Brick EMS and Medic205 arrived on scene \_\_\_\_\_ began to regain consciousness. \_\_\_\_\_ advised me he had used 2 bags of heroin. On scene I recovered 2 empty wax folds. One was located inside the kitchen garbage and was labeled Set It Off. The other was located in the toilet and was labeled with an unreadable green stamp. \_\_\_\_\_ was transported to Brick Hospital for further treatment. \_\_\_\_\_ requested to leave the residence unlocked as he was unsure of where his keys were.

Upon leaving the residence I was approached by a neighbor, who wished to remain anonymous. The neighbor advised me that prior to EMS's arrival he observed a male subject, fitting \_\_\_\_\_ description, exit the residence and enter the rear passenger side of a black vehicle parked in the driveway. The subject then appeared to place something into his pants pocket before running from the scene. The vehicle, a black Jeep Liberty NJ Registration L13HNN, \_\_\_\_\_ who is \_\_\_\_\_ step mother and lives at the residence.

I responded to Brick Hospital and spoke with \_\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_ stated he and \_\_\_\_\_ had been hanging out prior to him overdosing and \_\_\_\_\_ was with him just prior to using the heroin.

I contacted the on call DEU Detective, Sgt. Petrola #201, and advised him of the incident.

I safely discarded the syringe at Brick Hospital and entered the empty wax folds into property for destruction.

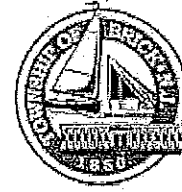

Upon our arrival I spoke with who advised she found her boyfriend, overdosing on heroin. relayed she was upstairs waiting on to grab a DVD from the downstairs which took an extended period of time. advised when she went downstairs to check on she found him slumped over in a chair with several empty wax folds sitting on the kitchen table.

I located at the kitchen table who was alert and conscious upon my arrival. initially denied using any CDS and claimed he was tired from taking his prescription but later admitted to consuming approximately 10 wax folds worth of Heroin. relayed he would voluntarily be transported to the hospital for treatment. Located on was a hypodermic syringe used to inject heroin, 10 wax folds containing suspect heroin, 10 empty wax folds used to package heroin all marked with "future" in red, green vegetation suspect marijuana and a quarter of a pill.

All evidence was seized and placed into property for destruction. was transported to Brick hospital without incident. and were both advised of the Blue Hart treatment program and Det. Petrola #201 of the DEU was notified of the incident.

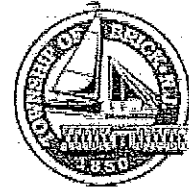

He is the landlord of the residence and was scheduled to show the house to a prospective buyer. He attempted to notify the suspect, [REDACTED], several times but was unable to get in touch with her. When he arrived at the house he observed [REDACTED] sleeping on the couch and snoring loudly. He made several attempts to wake her up but was unsuccessful, which is when he called 911.

Ptl. Vendrell and I attempted to wake [REDACTED] up several times but could only get her to open her eyes for a brief moment before she closed them. On 07-02-2018 at 2011hrs, Ptl. LaPoint #222, Ptl. Joaquim #271, Ptl. McGrath #277, and I, Ptl. Bailey #293 responded to in reference to an overdose. Dispatch advised the male subject was on the second floor unconscious on the bathroom floor.

Ptl. LaPoint and Ptl. Joaquim arrived on scene and observed the male laying on the bathroom floor, unconscious, unresponsive, and not breathing. The male also has constricted pupils. After feeling a pulse, Ptl. Joaquim administered the first dose of Narcan. Ptl. Joaquim continued to evaluate as he began to assemble his Bag Valve Mask and provide oxygen to After the first dose of Narcan, Ptl. Joaquim advised had shallow breathing and his pupils were pin pointed. Ptl. Joaquim stated stopped breathing once again and was requesting a second dose of Narcan.

Upon our arrival, we retrieved another dose of Narcan and entered the residence. Once inside we proceeded up the stairs to the bathroom, where I observed the male still unconscious and unresponsive on the floor. I administered another dose of Narcan approximately five minutes after the first dose. Once the second dose was administered, Ptl. Joaquim and I reapplied a bag valve mask to aid him with his breathing. After about one minute, began breathing and started to regain consciousness as Brick EMS arrived on scene. I observed eyes to be pin point and his breathing became normal. Ptl. Joaquim then found a syringe and two bags of suspected heroine in pocket while trying to obtain identification. The one bag of suspected heroine had "Chanel" stamped on it in purple ink, the other had no markings on it. Brick EMS then escorted him to the ambulance where he was transported to Brick Hospital for further evaluation and treatment.

While was being transported to the hospital, a call was made to the front desk to notify the Drug Enforcement Unit of the overdose but advised they would not be responding. While leaving the scene, a Blue Hart Magnet was placed on the refrigerator of the subject's residence.

The two suspected bags of heroin were logged into evidence and the hypodermic needle was disposed in a sharps container at Ocean Medical Center.
