INCIDENT: OVERDOSE

VICTIM: [REDACTED]

At approximately 1435 hours, Ptl. Elwood #425, Ptl. Lammer#407, Sgt. McDowell #312 and I responded to Building 2 (Bartlett Hall) at Ocean County College for a possible overdose.

Prior to our arrival on location, college security administered (1) dose of Narcan to the victim, [REDACTED] who they found breathing but unconscious in Room 116. Shortly after giving the dose of Narcan, [REDACTED] began to regain consciousness.

Upon arrival, [REDACTED] was standing upright and talking to EMS personnel who had arrived just prior to our arrival. [REDACTED] stated he did not know what happened and admittedly denies any narcotics use. [REDACTED] further stated that he he took [REDACTED] of Xanax, [REDACTED] more then his prescribed ([REDACTED] as needed) amount because he was trying to ease his anxiety and be social. [REDACTED] stated he did not take any other medication or drugs other then his daily prescribed anxiety medication; Prozac and one other that he does not recall its name.

[REDACTED] was transported by Silverton EMS to CMC for further medical evaluation.
