On Thursday, September 06, 2018, multiple TRPD units responded to the Walgreens located at Hooper and Church for a male overdosing in the parking lot. Upon arrival, I observed several members of TRFD Station 29 assessing Mr. [REDACTED]. According to one Firefighter, Mr. [REDACTED] was breathing but unresponsive to painful stimuli.

I pulled Mr. [REDACTED] from the vehicle and checked his carotid and radial pulses. Mr. [REDACTED] had both and was breathing. Silverton EMS members arrived and administered Narcan which revived Mr. [REDACTED]. He was transported by Silverton EMS to the hospital for evaluation.

Ptl. Lammer spoke with Mr. [REDACTED] "friends", Ms. [REDACTED] and Mr. [REDACTED]. They stated that they were with Mr. [REDACTED] and stated he injected heroin near the area of Route 9 and Route 70. When he became unresponsive they pulled into the Walgreens parking lot and contacted 911.

Next to Mr. [REDACTED] a capped syringe was located. Several bags bundled together when his pockets were checked for any uncapped sharp objects. All items were submitted into evidence to be destroyed.
