Toms River Police Department Investigation Narrative

On 09/07/2018 at 17:11 hours, the undersigned along with Sgt. Grob and Ptl. Beyerle were dispatched to Buffalo Wild Wings located at 2 Route 37 West for an overdose. Upon arrival Involved Person/Employee, was found on the women's bathroom floor unresponsive. With a sternum rub from EMS Ms. awoke and was combative swinging her arms. Ms. was placed in handcuffs for the safety of all while she was transported to Community Medical Center. One capped hypodermic syringe was located on the floor next to Ms. Ptl. Beyerle placed the syringe in the sharps container at District One. There was no other items located in the bathroom. Ms. was left in Pod 4 secure hold for further treatment.
