Investigation Narrative

On 09/07/2018 at 17:11 hours, the undersigned along with Sgt. Grob and Ptl. Beyerle were dispatched to Buffalo Wild Wings located at 2 Route 37 West for an overdose. Upon arrival [REDACTED] Involved Person/Employee, was found on the women's bathroom floor unresponsive. With a sternum rub from EMS Ms. [REDACTED] awoke and was combative swinging her arms. Ms. [REDACTED] was placed in handcuffs for the safety of all while she was transported to Community Medical Center. One capped hypodermic syringe was located on the floor next to Ms. [REDACTED]. Ptl. Beyerle placed the syringe in the sharps container at District One. There was no other items located in the bathroom. Ms. [REDACTED] was left in Pod 4 secure hold for further treatment.
