On 9/8/18 at approximately 1312 hours I was dispatched to Sunrise Detox located at 16 Whitesville Rd in reference to an overdose. Dispatch advised that a male, later identified as [REDACTED] overdosed in the lobby and was not responding.

Upon arrival, [REDACTED] was located alert and conscious sitting on the front steps of the facility. His pupils were pin pointed and he was slurring his speech. [REDACTED] advised that he took unknown amounts of Seroquel, Xanax and heroin prior to arriving at the facility. Silverton First Aid responded and ultimately transported [REDACTED] to Community Medical Center (CMC) for further treatment. Sunrise Detox stored [REDACTED] belonging while he's being treated at CMC. Prior to being transported, I searched [REDACTED] person for any illegal contraband however, none was located.
