On September 13, 2018 at approximately 1749 hours, I P.O. Ippolito responded to the Quick Check at 2309 Rt 88 for a report of an Overdose. Upon arrival, I observed a white male [REDACTED] in the drivers seat of a Silver Toyota Rav4 [REDACTED] on the west side of the building. The male was leaning over in the drivers seat, was not moving and appeared to be unconscious. I opened the door to check on the male who appeared to be struggling breathing and was non responsive to stimulus. I also observed an uncapped hypodermic needle on the arm rest of the vehicle right below his right arm. I checked for a pulse which was faint and administered one dose of Narcan. P.O. Phillips, P.O. Mergner, Sgt Wells, P.O. Barker and Lt Radsniak arrived on scene and assisted me in getting [REDACTED] out of the vehicle. Once out of the vehicle he was still non responsive and was drooling blood and saliva on his shirt. A second dose of Narcan was administered approximately 2 minutes later and [REDACTED] had started to come to.

First aid arrived on scene and transported [REDACTED] to Ocean Medical Center [REDACTED] (victims wife) was on scene and advised that she spoke to her husband an hour prior. When he did not come right home she became concerned. [REDACTED] began searching the area for him until she located him at Quick Check and called 911.

I placed the hypodermic needle in a sharps container and transported it to Ocean Medical Center to be disposed. I replenished both Narcan kits and returned to police headquarters. I completed the Naloxone Deployment report and forwarded it to P.O. Aurin. The report was faxed to the Ocean County Prosecutors Office and the NJSP ROIC for reporting.
