On September 5th, 2018 at 1750 hours, the Undersigned (U/S) was dispatched to mile marker 81.0 on the Garden State Parkway N/B for a report of CPR in progress on the side of the road. The U/S was advised by police dispatch that Quality Medical was on scene, and they were going to transport the victim to the hospital. Upon arrival at mile marker 81.0, the U/S could not locate the victim or Quality Medical.

The U/S proceeded onto the Garden State Parkway S/B and located the incident at 80.4 N/B. Upon arrival, the U/S was met by Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) from Quality Medical, who requested the U/S's narcans. EMTs advised that the victim, later identified as [REDACTED], had a pulse but was not breathing. They further advised that the victim's brother, [REDACTED], reported the victim recently used heroin.

The U/S administered one 2mg dose of nasal narcans to the victim. Several minutes later, the victim awoke and was transported to Community Medical Center by Quality Medical. There was no suspect heroin located at the scene.
