On the above date while on patrol, I (Patrolman Kraus) was facing southbound monitoring traffic at the intersection of Main Ave & Bridge Ave when a black vehicle traveling northbound on Main Ave was approaching the intersection. This officer noticed that the traffic light turned from amber to red and the vehicle in question disregarded the need to stop for the red light and went thru the intersection. It should be noted the vehicle in question had enough distance to safely come to a complete stop at the light which it failed to do so. I then turned my patrol vehicle around and closed the gap on the vehicle. Once closing the gap i activated my emergency lights conducting a motor vehicle stop at the intersection of Main Ave & Twilight Rd. I advised Ocean County Radio the New Jersey Registration V67KBL and location of the stop. Before approaching the vehicle I typed the registration in the MDT of patrol car 202. The Dmv response came back that the registered owner of the vehicle was suspended. I then exited my patrol car and approached the driver side window of the vehicle and came into contact with the suspended registered owner who will be identified as Brendan Dowd. I asked Dowd to produce his drivers license, registration, and insurance which he only could provide me was his license and registration. Dowd stated he could pull his insurance up on his cellphone. I then advised Dowd the reason for stopping him was for failing to stop at the red light at the intersection of Main Ave & Bridge Ave., and that his license was also coming up suspended. Dowd stated his license was probably suspended for parking tickets which he stated he paid but could not provide any proof that he paid the summonses. While speaking with Dowd i could detect an odor of alcoholic beverage emulating from the cabin of the vehicle. I asked Dowd where he was heading tonight and if he had anything to drink which he stated no he has not had one drink tonight and that he was on his way to Broadway Bar & Grill to eat.

After speaking with Dowd I returned to my patrol car and advised Ocean County Radio that i was out with the registered owner and asked for the date and reason for suspension. Ocean County Radio stated the reason for suspension was due to Parking Offenses Adjudication Act with the date of December 30,2018. Due to the smell of alcoholic beverage while speaking with Dowd and that Dowd had glossy eyes and some slurred speech while speaking with this officer, I asked Dowd if he consumed any alcohol tonight which he stated no. I advised Dowd i was going to run him thru several tests to determine if he was under the influence of alcohol. Dowd stated that he would complete any test.

I then asked Dowd what his highest level of education is and if he was proficient in the english alphabet which he stated high school and yes he knew the alphabet. I then advised Dowd that he would recite the alphabet starting from the letter A and ending in the letter Z. I then demonstrated the test which i wanted him to perform and he was also advised not to hum or sing the letters out. After explaining and demonstrating the test to Dowd he was advised to begin. While reciting the alphabet Dowd recited the letters in a fast pace and after reciting the letter T he recited U,W,V,Y,C,B,Z. It should be noted while conducting the test i could detect an odor of alcoholic beverage emulating off of Dowd's breathe. Once he finished reciting the alphabet I asked Dowd to exit the vehicle and walk over to the sidewalk so I could perform further psychophysical examinations on him. It should be noted the area where the tests would be performed was flat, level, and free of any obstructions.

Once on the sidewalk I explained the next test to Dowd which was going to be the One-Leg Stand. I advised Dowd to stand with his feet together and hands down at his sides while i explained and demonstrated the test and not to begin until advised to do so. I then explained to Dowd that with a foot of his choice to elevate it six inches off the ground and to point his toe down towards the pavement. While doing so he would recite the numbers one-one thousand up to thirty one-one thousand. He was also advised not to use him arms to balance and to keep them down at his sides during the test. Before beginning i asked Dowd if he had any injuries or issues that would affect him in conducting the test which he stated no. Dowd was then advised to begin whenever he was ready. While attempting the test Dowd failed to elevate his foot six inches off the ground for the majority of the test and kept the heel of his foot only a inch off the pavement. Dowd also put his foot completely down while reciting ten one-thousand and repeated ten one-thousand twice. Dowd also failed to

recite thirteen one-thousand and repeated fourteen one-thousand twice and put his foot completely down. When reciting fifteen one-thousand he used his arms to balance and stumbled putting his foot down again. Dowd was then ordered to stop.

I then advised Dowd that we would move on to the third test which would be the Walk & Turn. I advised Dowd to keep his hands down at his sides and to start with the foot of his choice, one in front of the other. I then explained and demonstrated to Dowd he would take a series of nine heel to toe steps reciting each number aloud. Once completing the first series of steps he would take a series of small steps turning 180 degrees and completing a second series of nine heel to toe steps reciting the number aloud. Once explaining the test to Dowd i asked him if he had any injuries or issues in conducting this test which he stated no. Dowd was then advised to begin the test whenever he was ready. Dowd completed both series of steps without incident.

Based on all of my observations Dowd was then placed under arrest for D.W.I, handcuffed utilizing the double locking method. Dowd was then searched and placed in the rear of patrol car 202. Ocean County was advised of the arrest and to get in contact with All-Time Auto Body for a impound as per Johns Law. Officer Molhem from Mantoloking Police stayed on scene with the vehicle to wait for the tow truck and i transported Dowd to police headquarters to utilize the Alcotest machine.

Upon arrival to police headquarters I escorted Dowd into the booking area. Before entering the booking area i secured my weapon in the gun locker and Dowd was then placed on the bench in the processing room with his left wrist handcuffed to the bench I then read Dowd his Miranda Warnings which he stated he understood. Dowds belongings were placed in the property locker outside the booking area. Upon the arrival of Sgt.Keller who was called in to conduct breathe testing on Dowd i read the standard statement for operators of a motor vehicle, N.J.S.A 39:4-50.2(E) to Dowd. Dowd responded that he would submit to breathe testing. Prior to starting the twenty minute observation of Dowd i had him open his mouth and lift his tongue and i did not observe any objects in his mouth. I then began the twenty minute observation. During the twenty minute observation Dowd remained alert and conscious and did not burp or vomit. Once the twenty minute observation concluded Sgt.Keller took over to run the Alcotest (See Sgt Keller supplemental). Once the breathe testing was completed it was determined that Dowd had a blood alcohol content of .07% B.A.C. He was then handed his cellphone to make calls to arrange for a ride to be released. While waiting for his ride I issued Dowd summonses #1502-BH-015208 for 39:4-81(Failure to observe signal), #1502-BH-015209 for 39:3-40(Suspended D.L), #1502-BH-015210 for 39:4-50(D.W.I), and #1502-BH-015211 for 39:4-96(Reckless Driving). Emily Mcmahon who Dowd contacted for a ride home, arrived at police headquarters to pick up Dowd and was given the potential liability form which she signed without issue and received a copy of the form. Before releasing Dowd he was advised of the summonses he was being issued and that they were court mandatory summonses with the date of February 14,2019 at 4:00 p.m. Dowd was also advised if he could not attend the court date to call the number listed on the back of the summons. I also explained that he would need to wait twelve hours then come to police headquarters with a valid driver to get his vehicle released from impound. After explaining everything to Dowd he was released to his ride and patrol cleared.

On January 15th at approximately 11:40 hours, I responded to headquarters to conduct breath tests on Brendan Dowd, who had been arrested by Patrolman Joseph K Kraus for driving under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs.

Upon my arrival at 1140 hours, I made contact with Mr. Dowd, who was seated in the holding room. At that time, Patroman Kraus stated he had already begun the twenty-minute observation period. At this time, I could detect an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from 's breath.

Prior to being placed in the holding room, Mr Dowd was checked by Patroman Kraus and was free of any
