 On 10/28/2018, Myself along with P.O.'s Kelly #215 and Travisano #259 responded to [REDACTED] Diamond Road for a report of a 9-1-1 first aid call and possible heroin overdose. Dispatch advised the individual was unresponsive inside the bathroom of the residence and his mother was unable to open the door. Upon arrival, myself and P.O. Kelly #215 entered the bi-level structure and proceeded to the upstairs bathroom where the individual, (Robert Vazquez) was located. This officer observed the bathroom door to be slightly ajar and was obstructed by Mr. Vazquez's body, specifically his head. Officers were able to open the bathroom door enough to squeeze inside without causing harm to Mr. Vazquez.

While inside the bathroom, Mr. Vazquez was observed lying, naked, from the waist down, face down, horizontally on the floor and exhibited labored breathing. He was unresponsive, blue in color and nasally. This officer observed a hypodermic needle lying on the floor next to the toilet, across from where Vazquez was located and not in harms way. Officers repositioned Mr. Vazquez face up, in order to administer the narkan.

At this time, P.O. Travisano #259 and Quality first aid #147 also had arrived and assisted providing first aid. This officer was conducting sternal rubs to Vazquez as well as shaking and yelling his name. P.O. Travisano #259 attempted to administer Narcan from his Automated External Defibrillator #3, (AED) but cracked the vial upon securing it into the capsule. A second Narcan was equipped and one dose was administered by Quality First Aid Officer Ramos, from Jackson Police Defibrillator #4, Lot #RL06317, expiration, 08/2019. Within a couple of minutes, Mr. Vazquez was revived due to the narkan and escorted out of the bathroom and seated on the couch in the living room. Quality continued to treat Mr. Vazquez and recorded his blood pressure, which was 190/110. He was then transported to Monmouth Medical Southern Campus for further treatment without incident.

This officer seized the hypodermic needle from the bathroom and secured it in a SHARPS container. Said needle was transported to police headquarters and placed into evidence.

While at Police Headquarters, this officer completed The Narcan Deployment Reporting Form, specifically directed by the Ocean County Prosecutors Office. Said form was faxed to Ocean County Radio Room and scanned and attached to this case.

It should be noted that this is the fifth, (5th) time this agency has responded to Mr. Vazquez's residence over the past year for similar incidents. See case numbers:

On 11/1/2018 at approximately 1744 hours I was dispatched to the Wawa parking lot located at East Veterans Highway for a report of an unconscious male in a vehicle. Upon arrival I observed a male, later identified as Mark Sobroza, slumped over in a vehicle. The registration on the vehicle was identified as New Jersey T69GPY. I observed that Mark's pupils were pin point, which I know from my training and experience is a sign of an opiate overdose. I then utilized my department issued narkan and appropriately administered it to Mark. Upon the arrival of Quality First Aid, I transferred all care to the arriving emergency medical technicians. Mark eventually regained consciousness and was transported to Monmouth Medical Center Southern Campus.

Justin's girlfriend, later identified as Kylie Taylor, stated in effect that the Justin snorts and injects heroin as a form of use.

I administered one dose of narkan with no response from the victim. First aid then administered 2 additional doses of narkan before the victim regained consciousness. The victim was refusing to go to the hospital at first but we were able to get him to walk to the ambulance. In the back of the ambulance the victim began to argue with members of first aid stating that he did not want to go to the hospital. I explained to the victim that due to his overdose it is in our policy for him to go to the hospital to get checked to make sure he is okay.

Officer Morizio located rolled up dollar bills and straws on the dresser located at the end of his bed. The drug paraphernalia was inside of a black candle. The paraphernalia was seized as evidence and secured in the rear of Officer Morizio's patrol vehicle, vehicle #181.

While the victim was in the back of the ambulance I spoke to his girlfriend later identified as Kylie Taylor. Kylie stated his name was Justin but was unsure of how to spell his last name.

While in the back of the ambulance I asked the victim for his name and date of birth. Justin stated in effect his name was Justin Walengewicz with a date of birth of [REDACTED]. After given the necessary information to first aid Justin began to calm down and started to go to sleep. Justin slept for a majority of the ride to MMCSC (Monmouth Medical Center Southern Campus).

Upon arrival at MMCSC Justin woke up and was agitated stating he did not wish to go to the hospital and I continued to explain to him that it is part of our procedure and he has to go. I explained to Justin that the more cooperative he is the smoother it would go and the sooner he would be released. Justin began to comply and was no longer a problem to any staff members.

It should be noted that while back at headquarters when beginning my report. I was unable to locate a drivers license number for a Justin Walengewicz. So I checked to see if we had any incidents at the residence prior to this. I was able to find a name Justin Murray with the same date of birth of [REDACTED]. A search revealed both traffic and criminal warrants for Justin.

The drug paraphernalia was labeled as evidence (for destruction) and secured in a temporary storage locker by this officer.

No further action taken by this officer.

At this time the medics arrived on scene and took over care. They had to administer narcan intravenously and this brought Wayne out of the overdose. He was alert and conscious.

I immediately assessed the victim, later identified as Jerome Maghan who was unresponsive and not breathing. Jerome was slumped over forward and he seemed to have an extremely low or no pulse. I checked Jerome's eyes and his pupils were pinpoint, indicating recent Opioid use. Jerome also had a hospital bracelet on and a bracelet which stated that he uses a type of Suboxone.

I shook Jerome several times and yelled in attempt to wake him up, but he did not respond at all. I also did a sternum rub, but Jerome was unresponsive.

I administered one dose of Narcan evenly in each of Jerome's nostrils. Jerome started breathing heavier seconds after the Narcan was administered. I then continued to perform rescue breathing on Jerome until EMS arrived.

Quality first aid arrived on scene to assist and took over care. A second dose of narcan was administered by the fire department, approximately five (5) minutes later.

Jerome became more alert after the second dose of narcan and was responsive.

Jerome was later transported to Monmouth Medical Center South Campus via ambulance with medics on board.

A search of the vehicle yielded negative results for drug evidence.

Jerome was transported without incident. I responded to the hospital as well and replenished the narcan for Defib #3.

Acetaminophen and Carisoprodol. T[REDACTED] showed me the two prescription bottles and upon further examination of said bottles, it was found that the prescriptions were prescribed on 11/26/2018. The Acetaminophen prescription was filled with 60 pills with each pill being 300/30 mg tabs. It stated one pill was to be taken four times daily when needed. The bottle contained 10 pills upon my examination. The Carisoprodol prescription was filled with 60 pills with each pill being a 350 mg tab. It also stated one pill was to be taken four times daily when needed. This bottle had zero pills left upon my examination.

At this time Officer Morizio #280, arrived on scene. I then asked Tvaroha why she had taken so many pills over the short duration from when they were prescribed to which she did not answer. Upon speaking further with Tvaroha her speech was very slurred and movements were very slow. I asked Tvaroha how many pills she had taken on the day of this report and she stated approximately twelve. Sergeant Grochowski #210 and Officer Ravaioli #276 arrived shortly after. It was determined that the two prescriptions were for back pain and depression.

It was then decided that mobile screener, Amy Gallo, should do an evaluation of Tvaroha due to the excessive consumption of the prescriptions. When asked if she wanted to do harm to herself or others, Tvaroha stated that she did not. T[REDACTED] then spoke out and called Tvaroha a liar saying that she "wanted to blow her brains out the other day." It was determined by Gallo and her supervisor that Tvaroha would need to be further evaluated at Monmouth Medical Center: Southern Campus. I then transported Tvaroha to said hospital with no problems. T[REDACTED] and her brother, identified as T[REDACTED], were picked up by their Uncle, identified as Harold Wood, and taken to his residence. No further action taken.

Ms. Patterson brought myself to the living room where Mr. John Abramski was found unconscious and not breathing on the couch from an apparent Drug Overdose. I alerted Police Dispatch to have Medics and First Aid as this was the call Ocean County received. I was soon joined by P.O. T. Conti.

A spent hypodermic syringe was retrieved from Mr. Abramski's side along with a homemade tourniquet. I then prepared a dose of 2mg Naloxone 18-28, Lot #: RL06317 Exp 08/19 and administered half in each of Mr. Abramski's nostrils. He was now agonal breathing with a pulse however still unresponsive. Several sternum rubs and verbal alerts later that were unsuccessful, P.O T. Conti prepared a second dose of 2mg Naloxone 18-30, Lot#: RL085E8 Exp 04/20. After the second dose of narcan Mr. Abramski was still unresponsive with no change in his condition.

Upon the arrival of Medics and First Aid, Mr. Abramski suddenly woke up. He refused medical treatment however was escorted by this officer in the rear of the ambulance to Monmouth Medical Southern Campus.

Approximately twelve (12) empty glassine bags were recovered several of which were stamped "Perragamo" in blue lettering. Two (2) small clear plastic bags of crack cocaine, One (1) burnt glass crack pipe, Two (2) hypodermic needles and six (6) spoons with suspected heroin residue were recovered from the scene.

Evidence was collected, photographed, logged, labeled and placed in a Jackson Police Evidence Locker.

At approximately 03:00 Mr. Abramski called this agency from his home after promptly being discharged from the hospital. He requested to speak to an officer because he was concerned with precisely how much cocaine and other drugs were taken from his home. He was advised that all contraband is removed upon responding to an overdose.

I then collected the wax folds and used syringe and placed them into an evidence bag.

After collecting the evidence, I spoke to the witness Joshua Danski. According to Joshua, Jenna had been in the bathroom for over a half hour. When he knocked on the door, Joshua did not get an answer. He then returned to the front counter where he located the bathroom key. Joshua opened the bathroom door and discovered Jenna laying on the floor unresponsive. After a few minutes, Jenna awoke on her own.

After first aid was done with their assessment of Jenna, she declined to be transported to the hospital.

At no time was Jenna administered Narcan.

Due to the overdose prevention act, Jenna was not charged with possession of heroin.

I then placed the evidence into my patrol vehicle 180 and responded to Jackson police headquarters for evidence inventory.

Jenna was in possession of:

six (6) empty wax paper folds

seven (7) wax paper folds containing a brown powder believed to be heroin

one (1) used syringe

All wax paper folds had a blue "candy crush" stamp on the outside.

The wax paper folds and syringe were photographed and attached to this report. The wax paper folds were submitted into evidence for destruction while the syringe was disposed of in a sharps container located at headquarters.
