## OfficerID: MFirneno, Narrative

On 02/03/2019 at approximately 2120 hours, Ptl. Fogarty #211, Ptl. Aksdal #255, and I were dispatched to Domino's Pizza (11 Lanes Mill Road) in reference to a disorderly person. While en route dispatch advised the suspect left the area in a sedan bearing NJ Registration Y55JPL.

While canvassing the area, Ptl. Fogarty advised he was conducting a stop of the suspect vehicle in the area of the Herbertsville School. Ptl. Aksdal arrived on scene. Ptl. Fogarty requested Stafford's credentials. As Stafford attempted to retrieve his credentials, Ptl. Fogarty observed several open containers of alcohol in plain view. Ptl. Fogarty asked Stafford to hand him the alcohol, Stafford handed Ptl. Fogarty an open empty can of Budweiser, and two 100ml glass bottles of Hennessy that appeared to be almost empty. Ptl. Fogarty placed the bottles on the roof of Stafford's vehicle and returned to his vehicle. At this time I arrived on scene.

As I approached the vehicle I observed Stafford sitting in the driver's seat. Stafford asked me where his car would be taken too. I told him we did not know if his car was going to be impounded or not yet, but if it was that I would let him know. Stafford reached for a plastic container of water, he looked at me and asked if I wanted some. I observed Stafford struggle to open the top of his water his hands movements were slow and fumbling. After his hands slipped off the cover multiple times, he was finally able to remove the lid. While speaking, he looked at Ptl. Aksdal and shouted "What you looking at bitch!" While standing at the side of the vehicle, Stafford continued to scream obscenities at Ptl. Aksdal. Ptl. Fogarty returned to the vehicle, he asked Stafford to step out and speak with us. Stafford exited his vehicle stating "I already know, I already know asshole" As Stafford exited his vehicle, I could detect the smell of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his person. Ptl. Fogarty explained to Stafford we would be administering him field sobriety tests due to our belief he had consumed alcohol. Ptl. Fogarty administered Stafford the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test. (HGN).

After explaining Stafford the HGN test he began administering. After being told not to move his head, Stafford continued to do so. Ptl. Fogarty explained the test again, and asked Stafford if he understood. Stafford did not answer. After being asked again if he understood, Stafford stated "Man, I'm fucked up man, come on." Ptl. Fogarty again administered the test. (See Ptl. Fogarty's supplemental report).

I requested Stafford to walk over to the area of the parking spaces, which appeared to be a flat, level and well lit space, free of debris. As I attempted to explain the one legged stand test to Stafford I noticed his eye's which appeared to be glassy and blood shot. As I explained the test I told Stafford not to start until I instructed him too. Stafford looked at me and asked which leg. I told him which ever he liked. Stafford then started the test before being instructed by me to do so. I told Stafford to stop as I re-explained the test. Stafford struggled to maintain the starting position, he swayed side to side and took steps to catch his balance. Stafford looked at me, shrugged his shoulders and said "I cant do it" I told Stafford to relax and attempt the test one more time. Stafford took a deep breath, and attempted to stand in the starting position. Stafford again swayed, and could not keep his balance.

I advised Stafford we would administer one more test. Stafford became frustrated, he loudly explained we already found the Hennessy bottles inside his car and questioned why we had to waste time taking the test. Stafford was advised it was procedure and it needed to be done. Stafford was uncooperative, and came close to having the test terminated due do his refusal to take them. I explained and showed Stafford the walk and turn test. After multiple attempts, Stafford was not able to successfully stand in the starting position with his hands to his side standing heel to toe. As Stafford attempted to take the position, he swayed and took steps to the side to keep balance. Stafford stated "Man it's over". I placed Stafford's hands behind his back and placed him under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated (39:4-50). Stafford was walked to the rear of patrol vehicle #26 and searched incident to arrest. (negative results). Stafford was placed in the rear of vehicle #26 and transported to police headquarters. Ptl. Aksdal remained on scene waiting for Route 88 Towing to arrive and impound the vehicle under John's Law.

Ptl. Fogarty arrived at police headquarters to work the Alco Test machine. (See Ptl. Fogarty's supplemental report) Prior to the Alco Test being administered, the room was cleared of any electronic devices (i.e. Cell phones, portable radios, Body worn cameras etc.) After providing acceptable breath samples, Stafford's blood alcohol contact was determined to be .275% BAC

Stafford was released a short time later to who signed and was supplied with a copy of the strict liability form. The open containers of alcohol located inside Stafford's vehicle were secured in department issued evidence bags and stored in property as evidence. Stafford was issued with the following:

## OfficerID: mstorch, Narrative

On 2/5/19 at approximately 2031 hours, I responded to the intersection of Cherry Quay Road and Tiller Lane to assist Sgt Matthews #210 with a motor vehicle crash.

On arrival, I observed a blue Ford Fusion, bearing Pennsylvania registration GCV8929, off the roadway into the rock landscaped area of 21 Tiller Lane. The front end of the vehicle was lodged on a large boulder with the front end slightly lifted off the ground. The driver of the vehicle, later identified as Kevin Maloney, was standing outside the vehicle speaking with Sgt Matthews. Ptl. Deluca #276 also responded to assist with the investigation.

While approaching Maloney, I observed him to be swaying while standing with Sgt, Matthews. I introduced myself to Mr. Maloney and asked him what happened. Maloney stated he was driving down Cherry Quay Road and slid into the rock while making a turn onto Tiller lane. Maloney stated he lives at 49 Royal Drive. Maloney was unable to accurately describe his direction of travel prior to the crash. His sense of direction was inaccurate. When asked, Maloney stated 49 Royal Drive is his permanent address and he has lived there for some time.

While speaking with Maloney I observed his speech to be slow and slightly slurred. Maloney swayed back and forth while standing still and moved his feet taking small steps to keep his balance.

I turned off the over head lights of the patrol vehicles and positioned Maloney in a safe, well lit area to perform a battery of Standardized Field Sobriety Tests consisting of Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test (HGN), One Leg Stand Test, Walk and Turn Test, and reciting of the English Alphabet.

HGN- Maloney failed to listen to direction and turned his head while following the stimuli. Maloney had a lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation and onset prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Maloney had a score of 6 on the Standardized Field Sobriety Checklist.

One Leg Stand Test- I explained and demonstrated the test to Maloney. Maloney failed to perform the test satisfactorily. Maloney started the test but failed to count out loud. Maloney raised his foot and placed it down to balance himself. When asked what number he counted to Maloney stated he put his foot down on the count of five (5). Maloney attempted the test a second time placing his foot down to balance himself on the count of three (3). Maloney attempted the test a third time. While performing the test Maloney raised his right arm and leaned on my patrol vehicle to balance himself. Another test was attempted with Maloney placing his foot down on the count of ten (10). The test was ended at this time.

Walk and Turn Test- I explained and demonstrated the walk and turn test to Maloney. Maloney failed to perform the test satisfactorily. Maloney failed to touch his heel to toe on his second (2nd), fifth (5th), and eighth (8th) steps. Maloney also walked off the line and raised his arms for balance during the test.

Alphabet Test- When asked, Maloney stated he is a college graduate and knows and understands the English alphabet. I requested Maloney recite the alphabet starting at the letter "C' and ending at the letter "P". Maloney started at the letter "A and continued past "P" finishing with the letter "Z".

At this time, I advised Maloney I was placing him under arrest for Driving Under the Influence (DUI). Maloney was handcuffed, double locked, and searched. The rear seat of vehicle #38 was also searched before securing Maloney in the vehicle. Maloney was transported to headquarters without incident.

Maloney's vehicle was impounded per John's Law. Point Pleasant Towing responded to the scene to dislodge the vehicle from the rock and store it in their impound lot. Ptl. Deluca completed a NJTR-1 crash report under the same case number.

At headquarters, I removed Maloney from my vehicle and searched the back seat prior to escorting Maloney inside the building. My weapon was secured in a gun locker prior to me escorting Maloney to the cell block. In the cell block Maloney was searched again prior to urinating in cell #1. Maloney was then secured in a prisoner belt with forward facing handcuffs. Maloney's twenty (20) minute observation started in the booking room at 2107 hours. During the observation period Maloney was read his Miranda Warning and the Standard Statement Form. Maloney signed the Miranda Form indicating he understood his rights and stated, "Yes" to providing samples of his breath for chemical testing on the Standard Statement Form.

At 2128 hours all electronic devices including my Body Worn Camera, cell phones, portable computers and portable radios were removed from the room. When asked if he had dentures or anything else in his mouth Maloney stated, "No". The Alcotest was initiated and the first chemical breath test was performed at 2136 hours. A second test was provided at 2139 hours. The chemical breath tests resulted in a BAC of .22%. The test results were found to be within acceptable tolerances in the State of New Jersey Alcotest Calculator.

Maloney was processed and released on the following Motor Vehicle Summonses: 1506-E19-000387 for 39:4-97 (Careless Driving) 1506-E19-000388 for 39:4-50 (DUI)

1506-E19-000389 for 39:4-96 (Reckless Driving) 1506-E19-000390 for 39:3-36 (Failure to change address)

Romi Gomes-Ferreira was contacted in reference to Maloney's arrest. A responded to headquarters were he was read the Potential Liability Form. Signed the form accepting responsibility. Maloney was released to Ferreira at 2258 hours.

## OfficerID: malexander, Narrative

On 02-07-2019 at approximately 0330 hours Patrolman Nixon #209 and I (Patrolman Alexander #216) were dispatched to the intersection of Route 88 and Jack Martin Boulevard for a report of a male sleeping behind the wheel of a Mazda Tribute.

Upon arrival in the area I observed a tan Mazda Tribute (New Jersey Registration H67FMA) facing north on Jack Martin Boulevard in the middle of the intersection of Route 88. This vehicle appeared to have been involved in an accident, as its front passenger side was badly damaged. I also observed the driver, later identified as Keith Gunther, to be passed out behind the wheel, with his head resting on the steering wheel. Patrolman Nixon was able to reach into the window and shut off the vehicle, which was running and still in the drive position. After turning off the vehicle we were able to wake Gunther by talking to him. As soon as Gunther woke up he was cooperative and polite, as if he did not realize he was passed out in the middle of the intersection. I asked him if he drank any alcoholic beverages tonight, to which he stated he did not. Due to our location in the roadway we had Gunther step out of the vehicle, and I moved his vehicle to a safer location, at 1893 Route 88 (Van Holton's Chocolates). Patrolman Nixon drove Gunther to this location, which was only across the street.

In the parking lot of Van Holton's I spoke with Gunther further. I did not smell any alcoholic beverages coming from him, but I did observe his eyes to be bloodshot, water and have droopy eyelids. Gunther was swaying as he was standing, and his voice was slurring as he spoke. Gunther appeared to be very tired. I questioned Gunther if there was any damage on his vehicle, and he stated there was not. Gunther advised me he did not get in any accidents tonight. I asked him again about drinking and if he was on medication or took illegal drugs, which he denied. I advised Gunther that I would like to perform field sobriety tests on him due to the situation with his vehicle and his appearance, to which he agreed.

The tests I had Gunther perform were The Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test, Walk and Turn Test and The One Leg Stand Test. I explained all the instructions for each test and I also demonstrated The Walk and Turn and The One Leg Stand Test. Gunther stated he understood all instructions. Prior to Gunther performing them I asked him if he had any injuries that would prevent him from doing the tests, and he rambled on about several injuries, but agreed to take them. See Brick Township Police Department Standardized Field Sobriety Checklist for results of the test. All tests were done on a flat and level portion of the parking lot, which was free from debris. Due to Gunther's poor performance of the tests I placed him under arrest. I then transported him to Brick Police Headquarters to be processed, without incident. His vehicle was towed and impounded, as per John's Law.

At headquarters I read Gunther his Miranda Rights and The Attorney General's Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators. Gunther stated he understood his rights and would provide breath samples. I observed Gunther in excess of twenty minutes before the test, at which time he did not belch or regurgitate. I also checked the inside of his mouth for any foreign objects or residual alcohol, which was negative. All electronics and portable radios that would interfere with the Alcotest were removed from the room. After all this I administered the test. Gunther had a reported breath test result of 0.00% BAC.

Due to his results a Drug Recognition Expert was called in. Patrolman Caulfield #235 of Brick Township Police Department responded as the DRE to perform further testing on Gunther. See his report for further details.

I issued summons' for DWI, Reckless Driving, Careless Driving and Obstructing the Passage of Other Vehicles to Gunther. After receiving those he was released to his daughter, , who signed the Potential Liability Warning.

The area was checked for any damage and the scene of the accident that occurred with Gunther's vehicle, but had negative results.

My body worn camera was activated during this incident.

## OfficerID: pmulcahey, Narrative

While on patrol on February 11, 2019 at approximately 16:29 hrs. I was at the intersection of Brick Blvd southbound and Cedarbridge Ave. I observed a Honda Civic Silver N.J. Reg. Y26HUT traveling at a high rate of speed on Cedarbridge Ave westbound and failed to stop at the intersection of Brick Blvd. I conducted a motor vehicle stop in the parking lot of Bob's All Around Car Care. When the driver, later identified as Jeffrey Hibberd stopped the vehicle he exited his vehicle quickly and was staring at me. I ordered him to get back in his vehicle. Hibberd then ran to the back of Riviera Plaza and was attempting to hide from me. I observed Hibberd running back towards his vehicle and I ordered him to stop. He complied and started to walked back towards me. When Hibberd was walking back to me he said that he was sorry and it was stupid for him to run. Hibberd said the only reason he ran was because his drivers license is suspended. I walked him over to my patrol vehicle and I detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his person. I asked him if he any alcoholic drinks today and he replied, "2 or 3 shots." As I was speaking to him I notice his speech was slurred, his eyes were blood shot and water. At this point I asked Hibberd to perform the Improved Sobriety Checklist battery.(see Improve Sobriety Checklist) After performing the test I determined that Hibberd was under the influence of alcohol and placed him under arrest for DWI and Obstructing the Administration of Law.

Sgt Matthews and Officer Storch arrived on scene to assist. Officer Storch went to Hibberd vehicle and observed on the driver seat 2 empty and 1 full Jim honey shooters. The shooter were photographed, copied to a disc, placed into property and the shooters were disposed of. Officer Storch attempted to retrieve Hibberd's insurance and registration card. Hibberd did not have proof of insurance in his vehicle. Hibberd's vehicle was towed as per John's Law and Officer Storch waited for the Glen's Towing to take the

vehicle for Andrew's Auto Body.

Enroute to H.Q. there was an odor of an alcoholic beverage filling the interior of my patrol vehicle #43 and Hibberd was very talkative. At H.Q. prior to entering the processing room I made sure that Hibberd did not have anything in his mouth. After reading Hibberd his rights and the standard statement, Hibberd was continuously observed for at least 20 minutes, during which time there was no indication that Hibberd had anything in his mouth or had regurgitated. A new, clean, sealed mouth piece was used for each test. Hibberd's BAC was recorded at 0.15%. The test results were confirmed within acceptable tolerance by the State of New Jersey Alcotest Calculator.

## OfficerID: mdefluri, Narrative

On February 14, 2019 at approximately 1649 hours I was on patrol driving east on Route 70. As I crossed over Burnt Tavern Road I observed a silver sedan that appeared to have a broken rear window pulled over and stopped in the shoulder of the roadway. Standing behind the vehicle was a male that appeared to be on the phone. I also observed an orange SUV pulled over in front of the silver sedan. I activated my emergency lights and pulled behind the vehicles to check on them.

I exited my vehicle and spoke to the male who was identified as Kurt Blatt. Kurt advised me that he was driving the vehicle stopped in front, an Orange Dodge SUV bearing NJ registration VKV83Z directly behind the silver sedan, a Lexus IS bearing NJ registration C96FYJ. Kurt explained that he was traveling east on route 70 behind the Lexus sedan when it veered off of the road to the right and struck multiple signs. Kurt stated he observed the signs and dirt flying through the air as the vehicle struck them. When the vehicle pulled to the shoulder Kurt pulled over to check on the driver. Kurt advised me that the driver appeared to be delirious and that she was now sitting in the passenger seat of the vehicle.

I then approached the passenger side of the Lexus where I observed a female later identified as Stacy Saltzman-Driscoll sitting in the passenger seat. The window to the vehicle was rolled down when I approached and I immediately detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the passenger compartment of the vehicle. I also observed Staci's face to be flush and her eyes to be bloodshot and watery. I asked Staci what happened and she stated she hit signs. I asked Staci where she hit the signs and she said on Route 70. When I asked where on Route 70 Staci was not able to answer me. I asked Staci where she was coming from and she stated a friends house in Toms River and that she was driving home to Manasquan. Staci explained that she was tired and that she was due to have surgery on her hip and that is why she was involved in an accident. I asked Staci to provide me her driver's license, registration, and insurance card. Staci grabbed her wallet and attempted to take her driver's license out and dropped it on the floor of the vehicle. Staci picked up her license and provided it to me, after which she provided me with her registration and insurance cards. Staci's hand movements were extremely slow and fumbling while acquiring her documents.

After speaking with Staci I contacted dispatch and requested an additional unit be dispatched to my location. Ptl. Chadwick #281 responded and checked the area for the scene of the crash which was determined to be in the area of Route 70 east near Macarthur Dr., see crash report by Ptl. Chadwick under the same case number. Ptl. LaPoint #22 also arrived on scene to assist.

Upon arrival of the assisting officers I approached the vehicle to further speak with Staci. I asked Staci again where she had been coming and she again stated she was coming from a friends house in Toms River. I asked if she had been drinking and she stated she was not and that she does not drink. I instructed Staci to exit the vehicle and walk towards the rear of her vehicle in front of my patrol car to perform some tests. The area of roadway was a flat and level surface that was free and clear of any obstructions or debris.

The first test conducted was the horizontal gaze nystagmus and was conducted by Ptl. LaPoint. Ptl. LaPoint explained the test to Staci and began. I had to stand behind Staci because she had stumbled backwards and I did not want her to fall. During the test Stacy continually moved her head back and forth and Plt. LaPoint had to instruct her multiple times to not move her head and only mover her eyes. Further, Ptl. LaPoint advised me that the result of the test revealed the following: lack of smooth pursuit in each eye, an onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in each eye and a distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation in each eye.

I conducted the rest of the tests, the second being the walk and turn test. I asked Staci if she had any injuries that would prevent her from conducting this test and she stated she had a hip injury. I asked if she could walk with the hip injury and she stated that she could. While explaining the test Staci stated she could not stand with her right heel touching her left toe and she almost fell over when she attempted to. For her safety I allowed her to stand with her feet together which she did. After explaining and demonstrating the test Staci stated she understood and I advised her to begin. Staci took approximately thirteen steps forward, none touching heel to toe, almost falling over, and I had to advise her to stop. Staci was unable to continue performing the test and I did not allow another attempt for her safety.

The last test was the one leg stand. I asked Staci if she would be able to attempt this test having a hip injury. Staci stated that she would be able to attempt it. I explained and demonstrated the test and Staci advised me that she understood. I advised her to begin and before she made an attempt she stated she was not able to and did not attempt the test.

Staci was placed under arrest, handcuffed utilizing the double locking method, searched, and placed in the rear of my marked patrol vehicle #14 to be transported to headquarters for processing. In Staci's jacket pocket were two airplane size bottles of vodka that were brought to headquarters, photographed, and destroyed.

Upon arrival at headquarters Staci was brought into the booking room where I conducted an uninterrupted twenty minute observation utilizing the clock on the computer. Prior to the observation period I observed Staci's oral cavity to be free of any foreign objects. Further, during the observation period she did not regurgitate or belch. At the completion of the twenty minute observation period I operated the Alcotest 7110 MKIII. Staci gave a total of two adequate breaths, each time utilizing a new mouthpiece. Staci's breath samples recorded 0.13% BAC. which were within acceptable tolerance.

I contacted Staci's husband, who responded to headquarters. vas explained and he signed the potential liability warning. Staci was charged with 39:4-50 and 39:-96 and released to Joseph's care.

## OfficerID: tcaulfield, Narrative

On 02/15/2019 at approximately 2354 hours, I, Ptl. Caulfield #235, was on patrol working a DUI (DDEF) grant detail in patrol vehicle #44. While traveling east bound on Route 70 in between Brick Blvd. and Route 88, I observed a 2015 Hyundai Elantra, bearing NJ registration R93JKZ, traveling in the far left lane. As the vehicle proceeded east on Route 70 towards the area of Princeton Avenue and Route 88, the vehicle quickly swerved to the right across two lanes of traffic. The vehicle never activated its turn signal when it went across the two lanes of traffic. When the vehicle approached the intersection of Route 70 E/Princeton Avenue, it moved from the second right hand lane into the far right hand lane without activating its turn signal. The vehicle then turned right onto Princeton Avenue from Route 70 E.

When the vehicle entered onto Princeton Avenue, I activated my patrol vehicle's overhead emergency lights to initiate a motor vehicle stop at which time the vehicle came to a stop in the right hand lane in front of 27 Princeton Avenue. After it came to a stop, the vehicle attempted to pull into the parking lot of 27 Princeton Avenue (Andrew's Auto Body). As the vehicle was pulling into said parking lot, the vehicle's rear passenger tire struck the curb. In addition, I also observed that the vehicle's center brake light wasn't working. At that time, I approached the front passenger side window, identified myself, advised the driver as to why I had stopped her, and requested the driver, identified as Caroline E. Rea, to exhibit her driving credentials.

As Rea was retrieving said driving documents, I immediately detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the cabin of the vehicle. In addition to Rea, there was a male front seat passenger, identified as Matthew Coeyman, seated inside the vehicle. As Rea continued looking for her documents, I observed her hand movements were slow and fumbling, her eyes were very watery, bloodshot, and her eyelids were heavy and droopy. Rea and Coeyman reported that they were driving home from a friend's house in Brick, NJ. When asked if she had consumed any alcoholic beverages, Rea stated he had two drinks while at said friend's house in Brick, NJ. Coeyman admitted that he too had been drinking at said friend's house in Brick, NJ. As I continued speaking with Rea, I also observed her speech was slow and slurred. Ptl. Rotondo #252 arrived on scene moments later for assistance.

At that time, I had Rea exit the vehicle in order to administer field sobriety tests in which she, Rea, had no objection to. As Rea was exiting her vehicle and walking towards the other side of the parking lot at 27 Princeton Avenue, I observed her slightly swaying and slightly staggering while walking. While Rea was standing in the parking lot near the front entrance doorway to 27 Princeton Avenue, I also observed that she was swaying while standing and her stance was rigid. In addition, a very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage was emanating from Rea's breath while speaking to her outside her vehicle. When asked if she had any medical conditions which would prohibit and/or affect her ability to the taking of the field sobriety tests/examinations, Rea stated no. The field sobriety tests/examinations were conducted in a well lit, flat area, free from any type of large cracks and/or debris.

The first examination administered was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test. After explaining to Rea as to how to perform the examination, Rea had no questions at which time I administered the examination. While administering the test, I observed lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and an onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Furthermore, I observed that Rea was swaying in both in a front to back and side to side motion during parts of the test.

The next examination conducted was the One-Leg-Stand test. While explaining and demonstrating the test, I observed that Rea was swaying while standing in the starting position. In addition, Rea lost her balance in the starting position and also started the examination before being told to begin. Once I fully demonstrated and explained the examination, Rea had no questions and was instructed to begin. While performing the examination, Rea was swaying while her right foot was elevated and also put her right foot down on more than one occasion. Rea then proceeded to lift her left foot after putting her right foot down. With her left foot raised, Rea was swaying continuously, used her arms for balance (Raised arms over six inches), and began hopping on more than one occasion. In addition, Rea only had both her right and left foot elevated approximately 3-4 inches off the ground while performing the test.

The final examination conducted was the Walk and Turn test. While explaining and demonstrating the test, Rea continued to sway while standing and had some difficulty maintaining her balance while in the starting position. After I fully demonstrated and explained the examination, Rea had no questions and was instructed to begin. While performing the test, Rea failed to touch heel to toe on almost every step, stopped walking on more than one occasion to steady herself, lost her balance while walking (Stepped off the line on more than one occasion), lost her balance while turning (Rea pivoted causing her to slightly stagger), and turned incorrectly (Failed to keep her lead foot on the ground). Rea also failed to turn 180 degrees as instructed. Instead, Rea turned 90 degrees to her right after completing the first set of nine steps.

Following the field sobriety tests/examinations, Rea was taken into custody (Handcuffs were double locked) and transported by me to Brick PD headquarters in patrol vehicle #44 without incident. Prior to placing Rea into my patrol car, I inspected Rea's oral cavity which yielded negative results/findings. Ptl. Rotondo #252 remained on scene and awaited Glen's Towing Co. to respond and impound the vehicle under John's Law. Coeyman was released from the scene without incident.

Once at police headquarters, Rea was read her Miranda Rights and signed off on the waiver portion of the form (Waived her rights). In addition, I also inspected Rea's oral cavity once again inside police headquarters which yielded negative results/findings. I then read Rea the NJ D.U.I. Standard Statement form (Implied Consent) in which she agreed to submit samples of her breath. I operated the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C machine and also observed Rea for twenty minutes (Twenty minutes were managed utilizing my personal wristwatch) prior to administering the test. During said observation time, Rea remained under constant and uninterrupted

observation until the administering of the Alcotest machine was fully complete. In addition, the Alcotest machine area was free from any type of electronic devices (i.e., portable radios, cellular telephones, etc.). Rea provided sufficient breath samples and her BAC was 0.17%. I then entered the Alcotest breath sample results into the NJSP Alcotest Calculator in which the breath sample results were within acceptable tolerance. Furthermore, a new mouthpiece was used each time Rea provided a breath sample into the Alcotest machine.

Rea was processed, as per department policy, and issued motor vehicle summonses for 39:4-50 (1506-E19-561), 39:4-96 (1506-E19-562), 39:4-97 (1506-E19-563), 39:4-88B (1506-E19-564), 39:4-126 (1506-E19-565), and 39:3-66 (1506-E19-566). Rea was released a short time later to a friend, who signed and was given the original copy of the Potential Liability form. In addition, Rea was given a copy of the Alcohol Influence Report from the Alcotest machine

## OfficerID: Kdocherty, Narrative

On 02/17/2019 at 1811 hours Ptl. Riccio (#289) and I, Ptl. Docherty (#275) were dispatched to the intersection of RT. 70 & Herbertsville Road for a report of a motor vehicle accident. Upon arrival, I observed two damaged vehicles obstructing traffic in the westbound lane at the intersection of Route 70 & Herbertsville Road. The first vehicle was a Ford Mustang black in color bearing registration (FL-ANICO). The second vehicle was a Honda Civic sedan gray in color bearing registration (NJ-U94CXT). Refer to Ptl. Riccio's motor vehicle accident report for further information (same case number).

I made contact with the driver of the Ford Mustang who was identified as Anthony Nicoletti who was standing in the roadway. I advised him to get back inside his vehicle for his safety and he complied. I asked him if he was injured and he stated he was not injured and declined first aid attention. Ptl. Riccio made contact with the driver of the Honda Civic who was identified as Grace Filkin. I asked Nicoletti what happened and he related that the other driver slammed on their brakes, which caused him to rear end the vehicle. While speaking with Nicoletti his speech was slow and he slurred his words. I also detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. I asked Nicoletti where he was coming from and he stated "River Rock", which is a bar located at 1600 RT. 70, Brick, NJ 08724. I asked Nicoletti how many alcoholic beverages he had consumed tonight and he stated "one drink". Ptl. Firneno #283 arrived on location at this time to assist.

During this time, I advised Nicoletti to exit his vehicle and he complied. There I advised him I was going to test him on a series of field sobriety tests. The below listed tests were explained and demonstrated by me and they were performed on a flat level surface, in a well-lit area free of debris. Prior to Nicoletti performing the tests, I asked him if he had any type of injuries or disabilities that would affect him from performing any type of physical tests and he stated "No".

Alphabet: I asked Nicoletti what his highest level of education was and if he understood the English language and its alphabet. Nicoletti stated his highest level of education was the 12th grade and that he understood the English language and its alphabet. Nicoletti was instructed to recite the letters in the alphabet from letters "F to U", without singing. Nicoletti began the test by reciting the following letters: "F, U". I explained the directions of the test to Nicoletti multiple times and he was unable to follow instructions each time. During my last set of instructions, Nicoletti related that he was unable to complete the test.

Walk and Turn: Nicoletti was instructed to stand with his hands at his sides and place his right foot in front of his left foot and stand in a heel to toe fashion, prior to him being given any further directions. Nicoletti was instructed to take nine steps heel to toe counting aloud for each step, while keeping his hands at his sides. After his ninth step, he was instructed to plant his front foot and take a small series of steps to turn around in the other direction and take another nine steps heel to toe.

Nicoletti was unable to stand with his hands at his sides in a heel to toe fashion as his arms were raised out past his sides. None of Nicoletti's first set of steps and second set of steps were in a straight heel to toe line. Several of Nicoletti's first set and second set of steps did not touch heel to toe as his feet faced outwards or inwards. As Nicoletti completed his first set of nine steps he came to a complete stop. I had to remind him of the test instructions again. He then took one large step and pivoted himself around in the other direction. I had to remind Nicoletti to count aloud multiple times as he continuously forgot to count aloud as he took each of his steps. Nicoletti continuously raised his arms out past his sides or placed his hands closer to his thighs to support/maintain his balance. Nicoletti's upper body swayed to support his balance throughout the majority of the test. Nicoletti was unable to follow instructions and complete the test as demonstrated.

One legged stand: Nicoletti was instructed to place his feet together and keep his arms by his sides. He was to raise his right leg six inches off of the ground in front of him without raising his arms for balance. Once in position, he was to count to thirty out loud by one thousands.

I had to explain the test instructions to Nicoletti multiple times as he repeatedly asked questions and had difficulty paying attention. Nicoletti started the test by lifting his right foot off of the ground and then dropped it back onto the ground at approximately eight (8) seconds. His body swayed back and forth and he raised his arms out past his sides during the majority of the test. Nicoletti did not count aloud by one thousandths as he continuously skipped numbers and forgot to count aloud. Nicoletti attempted to perform the test a second time and dropped his right foot back onto the ground after approximately five (5) seconds. Nicoletti was unable to follow instructions and complete the test as demonstrated.

After totaling my observations, it was my determination that Nicoletti was operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol and was subsequently placed under arrest for D.W.I. He was handcuffed to the rear, utilizing a double locking mechanism. Search incident to arrest revealed negative results. Nicoletti was then seat belted in the rear compartment of patrol car #24. A search of the suspect vehicle for open containers and intoxicants, revealed negative results. Ptl. Firneno remained on scene for D&L Towing to arrive on scene and impound Nicoletti's vehicle as per Johns Law. Nicoletti was then transported to police headquarters, where he was booked and processed as per departmental policy.

At 1857 hours I began a constant, uninterrupted observation of Nicoletti in excess of twenty (20) minutes. This observation continued throughout my entire contact with Nicoletti during which time he did not belch, vomit, or place any foreign objects inside his mouth. All portable electronic devices, including portable radios, cell phones and the laptop computer were removed from the booking room prior to testing. I advised Nicoletti of his Miranda rights, which he stated he understood. Nicoletti then signed the Waiver portion of the form. I read Nicoletti the NJ Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators and he stated he would provide samples of his breath for chemical testing.

After the 20 minute observation period (during which time Nicoletti did not regurgitate or place any foreign objects in his mouth), I activated the Alcotest 7110. I entered Nicoletti's information into the Alcotest and read him the standard instructions. Nicoletti stated he understood and was able to provide two breath samples. It should be noted that before each breath sample was provided I utilized a new mouthpiece (from a sealed plastic bag) to collect the breath samples from Nicoletti. Upon completion, his B.A.C.% was determined to be 0.14%. The results were provided to dispatch, who used the New Jersey State Police Alcotest Calculator to confirm that the results were in acceptable tolerance.


Nicoletti's friend, , arrived at headquarters in order to take responsibility of Nicoletti. She was explained the Potential Liability Form. She then signed the form stating she understood the Potential Liability Form and accepted custody of Nicoletti. He was then released from police custody and advised of his future court date.

- 6. Failure to possess Insurance card- 39:3-29c, E19-000604.

## OfficerID: Mcatalina, Narrative

On 2/19/2019 at 2350 hours, I was on patrol on Drum Point Road. I was traveling west on Drum Point Road, behind a silver sedan, 2015 KIA Forte bearing New Jersey Registration W93JGG, approaching the intersection of Hooper Avenue. The traffic signal for west bound lanes of travel was red. The silver KIA Forte approached the intersection and proceeded into the right lane of travel up to the light. The driver of the KIA Forte put the vehicle's right turn signal on. The driver then failed to come to a stop prior to make a right turn on the red traffic signal.

I followed the KIA Forte onto Hooper Avenue. While following I observed the KIA Forte to cross over the fog line in the area of Hooper Avenue and Lynnwood Avenue. The KIA Forte proceeded to the red traffic signal of Hooper Avenue and Mantoloking Road. The KIA proceeded into the right lane of travel leading up to the intersection. The KIA Forte stopped at the traffic light. When the traffic light turned green for the KIA Forte and my patrol vehicle to proceed through the intersection, the KIA Forte was paced doing seventeen miles per hour. The KIA Forte proceeded to continue at seventeen miles per hour through the intersection and approximately two hundred yards after. The KIA Forte continued on Hooper Avenue and proceeded to the ramp from Hooper Avenue to Brick Blvd. The KIA Forte failed to stop for the stop sign located there and traveled north on Brick Blvd. The KIA Forte sped up and I again paced the speed at sixty-five miles per hour in the 35 miles per hour zone. I activated my emergency lights as we approached the intersection of Brick Blvd and Rt. 70. I attempted to stop the vehicle in the parking lot of the old circle dodge, this way we were off of Rt 70. The driver of the KIA Forte stopped the vehicle half in the shoulder of Rt. 70 and the parking lot's last bit of entrance and exit.

I made a passenger side approach to the vehicle. The female driver was unaware I was at the passenger side of the vehicle even after I illumined my flashlight. When I illuminated my flashlight it illuminated most of the front passenger side. Blackwell had a hard time opening her glove box to her vehicle. She then attempted to reach over the passenger side and open the door instead of opening the window. I opened the passenger side door and asked the female, Veronica D. Blackwell, if she had power windows. She stated she did. I then put the window down and shut the door to prevent her belongings from falling out. I identified myself and asked Blackwell for her license, registration and proof of insurance. When she retrieved an item from the glove box which contained her documents she handed me her temporary registration which expired in 2017. She then provided me with her valid registration. I then asked Blackwell again for her license and proof of insurance. Blackwell opened her wallet, retrieved her New Jersey Driver's License and presented it to me. I then asked Blackwell a third time for her proof of insurance. Blackwell finally provided me with the correct document. It should be noted, while Blackwell was retrieving all the requested documents her hand motions were slow and fumbling. I then asked if she knew why I stopped her. Blackwell stated she did not. I advised her of the reasons. I then asked Blackwell where she was coming from and where she was heading to. Blackwell stated she was coming from a hotel in Brick and heading to "the sands" in Point Pleasant. She then stated she was coming from a friend's that lived in Brick off of Drum Point Road and going to the White Sands in Point Pleasant. It should be noted, Blackwell's speech was slow and slurred. At this time, I did not observe any containers of alcohol in plain view nor detect an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from inside the vehicle. I then asked Blackwell if she was on any medication or if she had any medical issues which she stated, "no." Ptl. Storch #206 arrived on scene to assist me. I advised Ptl. Storch I did not observe any containers of alcohol in plain view nor detect an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from inside the vehicle but believed Blackwell to be under the influence of some sort of narcotic. I asked Ptl. Storch to conduct the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test to confirm my observations. Ptl. Storch advised he observed lack of smooth pursuit, Nystagmus at the onset before 45 degrees and Nystagmus at maximum deviation in both left and right eyes, six hits of six. I approached the driver's side of the vehicle and asked Blackwell to step out of the vehicle. I asked Blackwell to walk to the building front to perform tests to see if she was okay to continue to drive. As we were walking towards the building front, I detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from Blackwell. As Blackwell was walking to the building front, she was walking staggered and appeared to be leaning and drifting to the left. I asked Blackwell to perform field sobriety tests. At this time, I conducted the field sobriety tests with Blackwell in an area which was well lit, level and free from debris.

Test 1. English Alphabet:

I asked Blackwell what the highest level of education she obtained was she replied I have some college and I am a license massage therapist. I then asked Blackwell if she knew the English Alphabet and if she could read and write the English Alphabet. She stated she did and could. I advised Blackwell the first test I would be asking her to perform is to state the English Alphabet. I advised Blackwell not to start the test until instructed to do so. I explained and demonstrated the test and asked Blackwell if she understood. She stated she did. I advised Blackwell to begin the test. Blackwell stated, "ABCDEFGHIJKLMNOP, HI, ABC, ABC, DFJ, HIJKLMNOP, QRSTUV, WXIZ." I then asked Blackwell if she wanted to retry the test. She stated she did. Blackwell completed the test from A to Z however she sang and grouped the letters.

Test 2. Walk and Turn:

I advised Blackwell I would be putting her in a starting position while I explained and demonstrated the test to her. I also advised her to remain in the starting position until I was finished explaining the instructions and not to begin the test until instructed to do so. Blackwell was advised to place her left foot in front of her right foot touching heel to toe. Blackwell was unable to put her feet completely heel to toe even after advising her that she was not heel to toe. Before I could start the demonstration Blackwell stepped out of the starting position and stayed that way while I explained and demonstrated the test. I then advised her to return to the starting position. I advised Blackwell the test was to take nine heel to toe steps forward, while looking down at her feet and counting out loud, when she got to nine steps she was advised to take small steps to turn herself around and take nine heel to toe steps back. Blackwell did take the correct number of steps however, she never touched heel to toe. Her steps were approximately fifteen inches

apart. Blackwell did not count her number of steps out loud as she was instructed to do.

Test 3. One Leg Stand:

I advised Blackwell I would be putting her in a starting position while I explained, demonstrated and advised her to remain in there until I was finished explaining the instructions. I advised Blackwell to stand with her feet together. I then asked Blackwell if she had any aliments or injuries that would affect her from performing the test. Blackwell stated she has a back and knee injury. I advised Blackwell to attempt the test if she wanted to. I advised Blackwell to lift the foot of her choice approximately six inches off of the ground and look down at her toe as she pointed it up. Blackwell was advised while doing that to count to thirty by one thousands. Blackwell was advised not to start before instructed to do so. I asked Blackwell if she understood the test. Blackwell stated, "Yeah you want me to lift my leg up and count." Blackwell was instructed to begin. Blackwell lifted her left leg approximately 10 inches off of the ground with a slightly bent knee. Blackwell made it to one thousand four then put her foot down to regain balance. I asked Blackwell if she wished to attempt the test again. Blackwell lifted her left leg again and stated one thousand three one thousand four. And put her foot down to stop her from falling over to her right. I then asked Blackwell if she wished to try the test again. Blackwell lifted her left leg and began to count one thousand one and put her foot down to regain her balance. Blackwell then lifted her left foot up again and began to count one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three and put her foot back down. I advised Blackwell to turn around and place her hands behind her back.

Based on my observations of Blackwell's tests I advised Blackwell she was being placed under arrest for driving while intoxicated. I handcuffed Blackwell, utilizing the double locking method. I searched Blackwell incident to arrest on scene. Ptl. Storch advised Police Dispatch I had an adult female in custody and we needed a hook for John's law. Ptl. Storch searched the vehicle for any open

alcoholic containers and remained on scene to wait for Glen's Towing.

I transported Blackwell to Police Headquarters for processing. At Police Headquarters, Ptl. Borden #274 and I walked Blackwell into cell block one and she where she was placed into a lap belt where her hands were handcuffed, utilizing the double locking method, in the front. I escorted Blackwell to the booking room. Blackwell was under my direct, uninterrupted observation for twenty minutes. During the observation period, Blackwell did not have anything in her mouth. During the observation period Blackwell did not belch or vomit and did not consume any food or drinks. All portable electronic devices were removed from the booking room. I advised Blackwell of her Miranda Warning Rights at 0032 hours. Blackwell agreed to the acknowledgement of her Miranda Rights and also signed off on the Miranda Warnings Form.

The NJ Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators was read to Blackwell. After completing the nine bullets, Blackwell stated, "Yes" when asked if she would submit samples of her breath. I then deactivated my body worn camera to

operate the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C.

I operated the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C. Blackwell was read the breath sample instructions verbatim, from the posted sign, which she stated she understood. The instructions were read for all three breath samples collections. The breath hose mouth pieces were changed after each breath sample was given.

Blackwell first breath sample was accepted. Blackwell second breath sample returned the error message of blowing time too short. Blackwell's third breath sample was accepted. The reported breath samples recorded was 0.17% BAC. The breath sample results were entered into the New Jersey State Police Alcotest Calculator, and were within acceptable tolerances. A copy of the Alcohol

Influence Report was provided to Blackwell upon her release.

After completing the breath test's Blackwell was placed back into cell block 1 cell 1. She was advised that she would need to have someone come to Police Headquarters to sign off on the potential Liability Warning Form. Blackwell stated she did not have anyone and asked why she could not just stay in our cell. I advised her she could not. At 0205 hours, Blackwell advised she was not feeling well. She stated she felt like her heart was racing. Brick Police EMS and Monoc 205 were dispatched and arrived at Police Headquarters. Brick Police EMS treated Blackwell and she refused to go to the hospital. At 0300 hours, after multiple attempts to locate someone that could pick up Blackwell, she stated she felt her blood pressure and pulse was high. She requested to have EMS responded back to Police Headquarters. Lakewood First Aid was dispatched and arrived at Police Headquarters. Blackwell advised Lakewood First Aid she would like to be transported to the hospital for her symptoms. While Blackwell was speaking with Lakewood was notified and she would be responding to Police Headquarters to sign the Potential First Aid I advised her that her sister Liability Form for Blackwell. Blackwell was released to the care of Lakewood First Aid and Kimball medical staff. Blackwell's sister, , responded to Police Headquarters to sign the Potential Liability Form for Blackwell.

My body worn camera was activated throughout the entirety of this incident. The backseat of my patrol vehicle was searched prior to and following the transport of Blackwell to headquarters. All weapons were secured prior to entering the cell area and processing room. Blackwell was searched again prior to being placed in a holding cell. Blackwell was screened for suicidal tendencies with negative results. Prisoner checks were conducted per departmental policy and guidelines.

## OfficerID: ccarter, Narrative

On 02/22/19 at approximately 2214 hours Ptl. Mancini #282 responded to the area of Burrsville Rd near the Garden State Parkway Exit 91 northbound for a motor vehicle complaint. Dispatch advised a Lexus bearing NJ Reg N31 CMC was driving aggressively and all over the roadway. Ptl. Mancini located the vehicle above in the 7-11 parking lot, 1151 Burnt Tavern Rd and found to be involved in a motor vehicle accident. Ptl. Mancini requested another patrol officer and I, Ptl. Carter #280 responded. See Ptl. Mancini's accident report for more details.

The vehicle was being operator by the owner, Thomas Weipz. Upon making contact with Weipz I could detect the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath when he spoke. When Weipz spoke I could detect a slurring of his words. I asked Weipz to accompany me out of the vehicle and he was led to a flat level area of the parking lot which was free of debris. Weipz was asked if he consumed any alcoholic beverages this evening to which he stated no. I advised Weipz I would be conducting a series of tests to judge his sobriety. I asked Weipz if he had any physical ailments that affect his balance or walking to which he advised no.

Weipz was explained the first test would be the one leg stand test. Prior to beginning the test Weipz was explained the starting position and asked to remain in that position for the remainder of the instructional phase. The test was explained and demonstrated for Weipz. I confirmed that Weipz understood the instructions and was asked to begin the test.

While explaining the test I observed Weipz swaying in a slight circular motion. When Weipz began the test his arms raised immediately and he began counting from 2 instead of 1. Weipz was only able to lift his foot for a very brief amount of time before having to place it down for balance. The time Weipz raised his foot was not sufficient enough to complete the test. Additionally Weipz did not look at his foot as instructed. Weipz failed the test despite numerous attempts.

Weipz was instructed the next test would be the walk and turn test. The starting position was demonstrated and Weipz was asked to remain in this position for the remainder of the instructional phase. The test was explained and demonstrated for Weipz. Weipz again advised he understood the instructions.

Again while explaining the test I observed Weipz swaying in a slight circular motion which became more pronounced. Weipz failed to remain in the starting position despite being asked to get back into the position several times. When Weipz began the test he raised his arms for balance and lost his balance while walking, stumbling from the line. Additionally Weipz took an incorrect amount of steps, stopping to steady himself.

Ptl. Mancini conducted the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test which indicated a failure resulting in a 6 of 6. During the testing Weipz continued to sway in a circular motion. See his supplemental report for more details.

Based on Weipz being unable to complete any of the tests and failing the tests he was placed in custody for driving while intoxicated. Weipz was placed in double locked mechanical restraints and transported to headquarters in patrol vehicle 07. The rear seat of vehicle 07 was searched prior to and after Weipz's transport. Once at Brick Police Headquarters all needed DWI paperwork was completed. Ptl. Catalina #263 responded as well to operate the Alcotest 7110. See his supplemental report for additional details. The Alcotest Calculator was deemed to be within acceptable tolerances and revealed a blood alcohol level of 0.14 Weipz was issued the following summons:

T 161660 Driving While Under the Influence (39:4-50)

responded to Headquarters and completed a Potential Liability Waiver acknowledging responsibility of Weipz. Weipz was released to and his vehicle was entered impounded into AEGIS.

On 2/22/2019 I responded to Police Headquarters to operate the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C in reference to Thomas J. Weipz (Weipz) who was in custody for DUI (See Case Report by Ptl. Carter #280).

On arrival, Weipz was escorted to the booking room. Weipz was under my direct, uninterrupted observation for twenty minutes. During the observation period, Weipz did not have anything in his mouth, drink or consume food. During the uninterrupted Twenty minute observation period Weipz belched. A second uninterrupted twenty minute observation was conducted. During the second uninterrupted twenty minute observation, Weipz belched again. A third uninterrupted twenty minute observation was conducted. During the third uninterrupted twenty minute observation Weipz did not have anything in his mouth, drink or consume food. All portable electronic devices were removed from the booking room. I advised Weipz of his Miranda Warning Rights at 2312 hours. Weipz agreed to the acknowledgement of his Miranda Rights and also signed off on the Miranda Warnings Form.

The NJ Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators was read to Weipz. After completing the nine bullets, Weipz stated, "Sure." when asked if he would submit samples of his breath.

I operated the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C. Weipz was read the breath sample instructions verbatim, from the posted sign, which he stated he understood. The instructions were read for all three breath samples collections. The breath hose mouth pieces were changed after each breath sample was given.

Weipz's first breath sample was accepted. Weipz's second breath sample returned the error message of minimum volume not achieved. Weipz's third breath sample was accepted. The reported breath samples recorded was 0.14% BAC. The breath sample results were entered into the New Jersey State Police Alcotest Calculator, and were within acceptable tolerances. A copy of the Alcohol Influence Report was provided to Weipz upon his release.

## OfficerID: emancini, Narrative

On 02/22/2019 at approximately 2219 hours I was Dispatched to the area of Burrsville Road and the Garden State Parkway exit in reference to a motor vehicle complaint. Dispatch advised me that a silver Lexus SUV, bearing NJ registration N31CMC, was driving erratically and the driver was possibly intoxicated.

While I was checking the area, I located a vehicle matching the description parked in the parking lot of Seven Eleven, 1151 Burnt Tavern Road. I approached the vehicle from the rear and activated my overhead emergency lights. While I was exiting my vehicle and approached the driver's side window, a male subject exited a vehicle parked next to the suspect vehicle and stated he was involved in an accident with the suspect vehicle. I then advised Dispatch to send an additional unit to which Ptl. Nixon #209 and Ptl. Carter #280 responded. The driver of the Lexus, identified as John Weipz, then exited the vehicle and also stated he was in an accident (see NJ-TR1 report for details).

Weipz stated he was driving to Brick from Bayville, and stated he did not know how the accident occurred. Weipz also stated he was looking at his cell phone during the collision. I asked him to provide the vehicle documents which he could only produce the vehicle registration and his license. I asked Weipz to remain in his vehicle while I spoke with the other driver and asked him to locate the vehicle insurance. He then replied that his insurance information was on his cell phone but he could not locate it because he dropped it during the crash. I then located the cell phone directly in front of him, through the steering wheel on the dashboard.

Weipz began slowly scrolling through applications on his phone and I noticed he was swaying in circles. While I was speaking with Weipz I noticed him slurring his speech and I detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. I asked him how much he had to drink and he stated, "Nothing."

Ptl. Carter then arrived on scene and implemented roadside field sobriety tests and asked me to conduct a horizontal gaze nystagmus test on Weipz.

I first asked Weipz to stand in the starting position which was standing with his feet together while holding his arms down at his sides. I asked Weipz if he had any physical defects or medical conditions affecting his vision to which he replied, "No." An initial medical assessment revealed no indication of vision ailments and Weipz confirmed he was able to see the stimulus.

During the test, Weipz displayed lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and onset of nystagmus prior to forty five degrees in both eyes. He did not display indication of vertical nystagmus. Weipz was swaying side to side during the test.

Ptl. Carter then placed Weipz under arrest. My department issued body worn camera was active throughout the entire incident as per departmental procedure.

## OfficerID: rtalty, Narrative

On 02/22/2019 between the hours of 2300-0300, I was assigned to D.U.I patrol. During this time, I was operating marked police vehicle (#28) in full police uniform. The weather was clear with light vehicular traffic.

At 2339 hours, I responded to Rainbow Diner (849 Route 70) in reference to a suspicious male subject. The caller also an employee from Brick Diner advised dispatch an intoxicated male subject leaving the establishment and enter a parked gold Lexus (NJ: D52HVS) in the parking lot. The employee advised dispatch the male smelled like alcohol and was falling out of his booth inside the restaurant.

Sgt. Thomas and I arrived on scene and located the vehicle in a parking space near the front entrance. I activated my Body Worn Camera (BWC) and exited my vehicle. The vehicle ignition was on and a male was seated in the driver seat. I approached the driver door and observed the male, later identified as Mark Claps, attempting to blow into an ignition interlock device. Claps head was between his legs as he attempted to use the device. Upon seeing me, Claps attempted to roll the window down but had trouble locating the button on the door. Eventually Claps located the button and rolled the window down; I made contact and identified myself as Police Officer. I observed Claps eyes were constricted. Claps speech was fast but slurred. Claps explained he just came from inside the diner and was grabbing paper towels from the bathroom. Claps continued to reach toward the floor. I requested he exit the vehicle to speak with me. Claps slowly exited while retrieving his identification. Claps began speaking fast explaining what he was doing inside the diner. While standing unsupported, Claps initially had trouble standing moving both feet. Claps explained how he is required to use an interlock device to operate his vehicle. As Claps spoke, I continued to notice his eyes moving rapidly and constricted. I detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming emanating from Claps breath. Claps denied drinking any alcoholic beverage but explained how he takes medication, specifically Klonopin, Adderall, and stomach medication.

Believing Claps to be under the influence of alcohol and/or narcotics, I requested he perform standardized field sobriety tests (SFSTs). Claps was directed to a clean, level, and well-lit area in the parking lot. The following psycho-physical (divided attention) tests were explained and demonstrated to Claps, 1) Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN), 2) Walk and Turn Test, 3) One Leg Stand Test. I asked Claps if he had any physical injuries which would prevent him from performing the tests, he replied "Knee" while pointing toward his left knee explaining two (2) previous surgeries he had. During my encounter with Claps, he was very talkative constantly changing subjects. Claps appeared to be agitated and scratched his head several times.

For the instruction phase of the first test, I instructed Claps to stand with his feet together and his arms at his sides while I explain the test. I advised Claps to keep his head still and move only his eyes for the test. I instructed Claps to follow the tip of my pen (stimulus) with his eyes only. Constricted pupil size and equal tracking was observed in both eyes. I conducted the test and at the conclusion of the test no HGN was present.

For the instruction phase of the second test, I instructed Claps to place his right foot in front of his left foot(heel to toe) as I explain and demonstrate the test. I instructed Claps he could start the test when I tell him to begin. Claps was unable to place his right foot in front of left. While explaining the instructions, Claps began walking without being told to begin. After explaining directions and demonstrating the test to Claps, I advised him to begin the test. Claps began walking never once touching heel to toe; both of Claps feet crossed each other while walking. Claps lost balance and crossed both legs while turning on the ninth step. While walking back, Claps stopped himself several times to regain balance. Claps lifted both arms form his side to maintain balance. At the conclusion of the test, Claps turned to face me and again lost balance.

I explained the final test, one-legged stand to Claps. He was instructed to raise the leg of his choice six inches from the ground while keeping his hands at his sides. Claps was instructed to count out loud one-one thousand, two-one thousand, and so on. Claps began the test by lifting his left leg off the ground; he maintained this position for approximately five (5) seconds and placed his leg on the ground. Claps lifted both arms several times to maintain balance. Claps had trouble maintaining balance and unable to successfully complete the test.

Based on Claps intention to operate his vehicle, the odor of an alcoholic beverage, signs of impairment, and his inability to follow my directions or successfully complete any of the divided attention tests, Claps was arrested for operating a motor vehicle under the influence. Claps was placed into custody and secured in the rear of my patrol vehicle. A search of Claps incident to arrest was conducted, the following was located in his possession:

1) One (1) pill container containing multiple medications he was prescribed, specifically Klonpin.

Prior to transporting Claps to headquarters, I placed his seatbelt on. While doing so, I observed his right nostril bleeding. I asked Claps if he was okay and needed first aid, he refused first aid stating his nose was "dry". Claps eyes were still constricted and speech was fast yet slurred.

Claps was transported to Police Headquarters in vehicle #28. At headquarters, I secured my duty weapon and escorted Claps to cell block #1 where he was searched per departmental policy. Claps was escorted to the JV holding room then processing room where

booking procedures began. This area was free from any type of electronic devices on me, Claps and any officers who entered the room (i.e., portable radios, cellular telephones, laptop, etc.). Claps was seated and read Miranda warnings at 00:18 hours. At 0020 hours, I began a constant, uninterrupted observation of Claps in excess of twenty minutes. This observation continued throughout my entire contact with Claps during which time he did not belch, vomit, or place anything in his mouth. I read the New Jersey D.W.I. Standard Statement form to Claps. When asked to provide breath samples, Claps stated "Absolutely". I operated the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C machine. Prior to operation, I deactivated and secured my BWC. After each test, a new clean mouth piece was used. At the conclusion of the test Claps provided sufficient breath samples yielding a BAC of 0.00%. I reactivated my BWC and escorted Claps to cell #2.

Believing Claps to be under the influence of a narcotic, I requested a Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) responded to headquarters to complete a DRE evaluation. DRE Brian Collins DRE#18867 (Manchester Police Department) responded to headquarters and administered a DRE evaluation. (See report by DRE Collins). Claps also provided urine which was placed into evidence for testing.

Claps was charged with the following motor vehicle offenses:

- 1) Driving while intoxicated 39:4-50
- 2) Reckless driving 39:4-96

## OfficerID: smesmer, Narrative

On 02/24/2019 at 2338 hours I (Ptl. Mesmer #292) was on patrol in marked patrol vehicle #03 and stopped at the traffic light at Burnt Tavern Rd northbound and Route 70. As the traffic light turned green to travel across Route 70, there was a dark colored Honda Fit in front of me bearing California registration 8GCZ925, that began to roll through the intersection. The vehicle then continued rolling through the intersection without accelerating and the light cycled through and once again turned red in violation of delaying traffic (39:4-56). I then activated my overhead emergency lights in belief that the vehicle may have become disabled or the driver may have been suffering from a medical emergency. The vehicle continued to roll approximately 150 ft northbound through the intersection in the left lane while I had my overhead lights and sirens activated. I then pulled my patrol vehicle next to the vehicle and I observed a male driver to be slumped over the steering wheel.

At that time I once again positioned my vehicle behind the vehicle and I alerted police dispatch to start Brick Police EMS to my location. The vehicle began to start rolling slower then it initially was and at that time I quickly exited my patrol vehicle in an attempt to get the vehicle to stop. I approached the driver's side window and began to knock loudly on the window while identifying myself as a police officer with no response. I observed a male driver unconscious and slumped over but breathing I then attempted to open the door to the vehicle in an attempt to get it to stop but the door was locked. After approximately twenty seconds of banging on the window the driver finally regained consciousness. The vehicle then came to a stop and I advised the driver to roll down the window several times without any compliance. The driver appeared to be lethargic and was not verbal while his eyes appeared bloodshot and watery. After approximately one minute the driver finally rolled the window down and I advised him multiple times to put the car in park. The driver reached to the windshield washer knob to put the vehicle in park and appeared confused. As the driver rolled the driver's window down, an overwhelming smell of alcohol was emanating from the passenger compartment of the vehicle. The driver was the sole occupant of the vehicle. I then asked the driver for his driving credentials and he was very slow in his movements as he began to look for the documents. The driver was identified as Casey Dowd Jr. I asked Dowd if he was suffering from any medical conditions and if he wanted to be checked out by first-aid and he stated "Honestly I do not want to be checked out by first aid". While Dowd spoke with me the smell of an alcoholic beverage was emanating from his breath.

At this time Ptl. Lardieri #251, Ptl. Riccio #289, and Ptl. Patrick #296 arrived on scene to assist. I then asked Dowd where he was coming from and he stated that he was coming from dinner with his sister. I further asked Dowd if he had consumed any alcoholic drinks this evening and he advised that he had two beers earlier. Dowd was then asked to exit his vehicle to perform field sobriety testing. As Dowd exited the vehicle, he appeared to stagger while getting out of the driver's seat. Dowd then walked to the front of his vehicle where I advised him that I was going to conduct field sobriety testing to which he initially agreed.

The field sobriety tests were conducted in a well-lit, flat area free from any type of large cracks or debris. Dowd had flat soled sneakers on during the testing. I asked Dowd what his highest level of education was and he stated 12th grade. I then asked Dowd if he understood the English language and he stated that he did.

The first examination conducted was to recite the alphabet. I first ordered Dowd to stand in the starting position with his feet together and his arms at his side while I explained the test. I then explained to Dowd that when I instruct him to begin he will recite the alphabet starting with the letter "B" and ending with the letter "O" without singing it. I then asked Dowd if he understood the instruction and he stated he did. Dowd then became agitated and said "I am just not feeling comfortable with the whole thing". I then asked Dowd once again if he understood the instructions and he stated he did. I then instructed Dowd to begin and he did not. I asked Dowd if he was going to complete the test and he replied "Never in my life time will I fucking do that". Dowd continued to sway while in the starting position and had to regain his balance several times.

The second examination conducted was the walk and turn. While explaining and demonstrating the test I instructed Dowd to remain in the starting position with his right foot in front of his left and his arms at his side during my instructions. I then explained that when I instructed Dowd to begin, he was to take nine heel to toe steps while counting out loud. Once he reached nine, he was to turn around utilizing small pivot steps and continue. I then asked Dowd if he understood my instructions which is when he replied "Yes sir". I then asked Dowd once again if he understood the instructions and he once again advised that he was not going to complete the test because "He did not know if it was worth it". Dowd once again lost his balance and became argumentative with officers. At that time I discontinued the test because he refused to complete it and out of concern for his safety.

Due to the traffic violations I observed, the inability to wake Dowd as his car was in motion, the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from Dowd's breath, his admission to drinking prior to this incident, and his failure to follow instructions during the administration of the psychophysical test, Dowd was placed under arrest for driving under the influence and handcuffed to the rear utilizing the double-locking mechanism. The rear seat of patrol vehicle #03 was checked for any contraband prior to securing Dowd. Dowd was then secured in the rear of marked patrol vehicle #03.

Ptl. Riccio #289 then conducted a search of the interior compartment of the vehicle that was readily accessible to the driver and located a clear plastic bag containing green vegetation, suspect marijuana, in the center console under Dowd's wallet. The suspect marijuana was then placed into a department issued evidence bag and secured in my patrol vehicle. Dowd was then transported to

Brick Police Headquarters for processing without incident.

Ptl. Lardieri #251 remained at the scene and awaited Route 88 Auto Body Towing Co. to respond and impound the vehicle under John's Law.

Ptl. Docherty #275 responded to Headquarters, to operate the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C machine. Ptl. Docherty further advised me that Dowd refused to provide breath samples. (See Ptl. Docherty's supplemental report for further).

Dowd was issued the following motor vehicle summonses:

Dowd was also charged with 2C:35-10a(4) (Possession of marijuana under 50) grams and 2C:36-2 (Possession of drug paraphernalia). Those charges were placed on summons S-2019-216 and Dowd was given a future court date.

A short time later responded to Brick Police Headquarters to pick up Dowd. . was explained the potential liability form and acknowledged by signing. He was then provided a copy of the form. Dowd was then released along with his property without incident to

Brick Police DEU was notified of this incident.

My department issued body worn camera was activated during this incident.

## OfficerID: Kdocherty, Narrative

On 02/24/2019 at approximately 0007 hours I, Ptl. Docherty #275 responded to Headquarters in reference to a DUI arrest to operate the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C for Ptl. Mesmer #292 (Refer to case report for further information). All portable electronic devices were removed from the booking room. At approximately 0015 hours, I began direct observation of the arrestee Casey Dowd. I observed that he did not have any foreign objects in his mouth, and did not have anything to eat or drink. At 0017 hours, I read Thomas his Miranda Rights to which he stated "I think I need a lawyer at this point" at 0021 hours.

The NJ Attorney General's Standard Statement was read to Dowd. He stated "I'm sorry to say no" at 0026 hours. I then read the additional NJ Attorney General's Standard Statement paragraph to Dowd and when asked if he would submit to breath testing a second time he stated "not doing a breath test" at 0027 hours. ## OfficerID: rtalty, Narrative

On 02/27/2019 at 2215 hours, I was traveling east on Drum Point Road just prior to the Mantoloking Bridge. During this time, I was assigned to the Patrol Division evening shift from 1500 - 0100 hours. I was operating marked police vehicles #35 in full police uniform.

While approaching the Mantoloking Bridge, I observed a silver Mercedes (VA:VVB5110) traveling westbound toward me. I estimated the vehicle to be traveling at approximately 55 MPH. I confirmed with my radar the vehicle to be traveling at 52 MPH in the area of Mantoloking Bridge Park. The vehicle passed me when I observed it pass over the right shoulder marking of Mantoloking Road. I turned my vehicle westbound and attempted to close the distance with the suspect vehicle. While behind the vehicle, I observed it again pass over the shoulder markings approximately five (5) times between Beaton Road and Tilton Road. I activated my emergency lights just prior to the entrance to Sandpiper Cove Development. The vehicle turned right into the development onto Tern Drive. I vehicle began to travel slowly toward Sandpiper Court. Eventually the vehicle pulled into a parking space in front of 403 Sandpiper Court.

I exited my vehicle and approached the driver door activating my Body Worn Camera (BWC). The female driver, later identified as Maureen Mahon, opened the driver door and attempted to exit the vehicle. I ordered the female stay in the vehicle and I identified myself as a police officer requesting she provide me with a license, registration, and insurance. Mahon opened her sun visor causing several pieces of paper to fall onto her. Mahon placed the papers onto the passenger seat and reached toward her rear pocket. Mahon stopped midway, and stared at me for several seconds stating "Hi, what's the problem?" I advised Mahon the reason for the stop and asked where she was driving from; Mahon advised me she left Jersey Mikes. Ptl. Mulcahey #130 arrived on location to assist also activating his BWC. Mahon continued to fumble several documents while looking for her license. Mahon provided me a Virginia driver license and insurance documents. I asked Mahon if she lived in the neighborhood, she stated she "maintained two residences". While speaking to Mahon her speech was slow as I detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanate from her breath. I asked Mahon if she had anything to drink, she stated "I had two (2) glasses of wine at my nieces" after previously stating she came from Jersey Mikes. While Mahon continued to look for her registration card, an unknown white male subject diverted my attention by walking toward the rear of Mahon's vehicle. The male asked Ptl. Mulcahey "what was going on" and refused to walk away. The male caused me to lose sight of Mahon as he continued to insist what we were doing. I advised the male to walk away but he refused placing his hands in his pockets. Mahon began exiting her vehicle as I continued to order the male to walk away. Eventually, he walked toward Tern Drive after being given several opportunities to walk away including observing the stop from a safe distance from officers. I re-approached Mahon as she continued to look for her registration while fumbling documents including a Sirius XM radio receipt.

I returned to my vehicle and conducted a DMV inquiry of Mahon. DMV returned Mahon's driving privileges were suspended. I re-approached Mahon's vehicle where I observed her holding a small dog. Mahon stated to me her driving privileges were suspended from DUI. I continued to detect an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanate from her breath as she spoke. Believing Mahon to be under the influence of alcohol, I requested she exit the vehicle perform standardized field sobriety tests (SFSTs). Mahon was directed to a clean, level, and well-lit area in the parking lot. The following psycho-physical (divided attention) tests were explained and demonstrated to Mahon, 1) Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN), 2) Walk and Turn Test, 3) One Leg Stand Test. Mahon exited the vehicle slowly and walked toward an area in the parking lot.

For the instruction phase of the first test, I instructed Mahon to stand with her feet together and her arms at her sides while I explain the test. I advised Mahon to keep her head still and move only her eyes for the test. I instructed Mahon to follow the tip of my pen (stimulus) with her eyes only. Equal pupil size and tracking were observed in both eyes. I conducted the test Mahon was given several opportunities but unable to follow the stimulus without moving her head. Mahon was not able to complete the test.

For the instruction phase of the second test, I directed Mahon to a yellow line in the parking lot which was a flat level surface free and clear of debris. Mahon was directed to place her right foot in front of her left foot (heel to toe) as I explain and demonstrate the test. She immediately began walking on the line without behind told to begin. I again advised Mahon to remain still with her right foot in front of her left foot. Mahon placed her hands in her pocket and was unable to follow directions. Mahon attempted several times but fell from the line losing balance. Mahon was unable to place her right foot in front of left. After explaining directions and demonstrating the test to Mahon, I advised her to begin the test. Mahon walked 12 steps off the line never once touching heel to toe. Mahon lifted both hands, turned around and walked nines steps losing balance several times. Mahon was unable to complete the test.

I explained the final test, one-legged stand to Mahon. She was instructed to raise her right foot six inches from the ground while keeping her hands at her sides. Mahon was instructed to count out loud one-one thousand, two-one thousand, and until told to stop. I demonstrated the test, Mahon began walking and lifting her foot. Mahon fell several times and was unable to complete the test.

Based on Mahon operation of her vehicle, the odor of an alcoholic beverage on her breath, admission to consuming alcohol, obvious signs of impairment, and her inability to follow my directions or successfully complete any of the divided attention tests, Mahon was arrested for operating a motor vehicle under the influence. Mahon was placed into custody, searched, and secured in the rear of my patrol vehicle. Mahon's dog was placed inside her residence by Ptl. Mulchaey; the garage door was left open and dog placed inside

through garage door.

Mahon was transported to Police Headquarters in vehicle #35. During the transport to Headquarters, the interior of my vehicle began to fill with the odor of an alcoholic beverage. At headquarters, I secured my duty weapon and escorted Mahon to cell block #1 where she was searched per departmental policy. Mahon was escorted to the processing room where booking procedures began. This area was free from any type of electronic devices on me, Mahon and any officers who entered the room. Mahon was seated and read Miranda warnings at 23:09 hours. At 2312 hours, I began a constant, uninterrupted observation of Mahon in excess of twenty minutes. This observation continued throughout my entire contact with Mahon during which time she did not vomit or place anything in her mouth. I read the New Jersey D.W.I. Standard Statement form to Mahon. When asked to provide breath samples, Mahon stated "Yeah". I operated the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C machine. Prior to operation, Mahon began asking question about having a lawyer present and not wanting to submit samples of her breath. To ensure Mahon understood her previous agreement to submit to testing, I read her the New Jersey D.W.I. Standard Statement form for a second time. Mahon requested to read the form herself which I allowed specially paragraph #7. Mahon eventually agreed to the test. I removed my BWC and secured it outside of the booking room. Mahon provided two (2) breath samples. After each test, a new clean mouth piece was used. At the conclusion of the test Mahon provided sufficient breath samples yielding a BAC of 0.21%. I reactivated my BWC and escorted Mahon to cell #1.

Outside of the residence, I spoke with Ashley Johnston, who advised me she and her boyfriend, Noah Mangan, had a dispute at the Brickhouse (989 Cedar Bridge Ave.). Johnston was asked if she is currently injured, which she stated "no". She did have an abrasion on the top of her forehead, which she informed me was not bothering her and she refused medical treatment. While speaking with Johnston, I detected a strong odor of alcoholic beverages on her breath. Her eyes were bloodshot and watery, and her eyelids were droopy. Johnston stated she drove from the establishment after consuming alcoholic drinks, to 365 Elm Ln., with Mangan. She reported she dropped Mangan at the residence and went to the Wawa (383 Drum Point Rd.) to check the rear tire of the vehicle. Johnston stated "I drove to the Wawa, made a right into the parking lot, hit that little triangle-median thing and everything went off". Johnston added "you guys pulled up right behind me (at the residence) and I was literally getting out of the car when you guys pulled up."

Sgt. Thomas exited the residence and asked if I could conduct the field sobriety tests for Johnston. Johnston could hear the conversation with Sgt. Thomas and I asked her if she understood what we were discussing, which she stated "absolutely I do". I explained to her that due to the fact she was driving, and consumed alcohol, I was going to administer field sobriety tests. Johnston replied "I know, I get it". Johnston was escorted to an area of the concrete sidewalk that was flat, free of debris, and lit by a street lamp. I also utilized my hand-held flashlight to illuminate the area in front of her.

I began explaining the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test to Johnston, and instructed her to stand with her feet together (heel to heel/toe to toe) and her arms down at her sides. She stated "can we do this not on a hill?". I advised her the area we were standing was not a hill, to which she pointed to the driveway apron, stating "oh, I thought we were there, I felt like I was leaning ". I raised the stimulus (a silver colored ball-point pen) approximately twelve to fifteen inches away from Johnston's face, and slightly above her eye level. she was asked if she could see the tip of the stimulus, which she stated "yes". I advised Johnston what I would be doing to complete the test which she stated "ok". She was asked if she understood my instructions, which she advised she did. I began the test, and the results were: lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, and distinct and sustained nystagmus present in both eyes at maximum deviation. While completing the test, Johnston was swaying from front to back.

The next test explained was the Walk and Turn Test. Johnston was instructed to stand with her right foot in front of her left foot, with her heel touching her toe, her arms down at her sides, and was told to remain in that position as the instructions for the test were given. I demonstrated how I wanted Johnston to stand, and I remained in the same position as I gave her the test instructions. At one point during the instructions, Johnston separated her feet and stepped out of the instructed position. She claimed to have been distracted as other officers were walking in the area. Johnston was advised to return to the same position, which she did. She was unable to keep her feet in the starting position prior to beginning the test. I explained the test to Johnston, and demonstrated how to complete it. She advised she understood and was instructed to begin the test. During the first 9 steps, Johnston was unable to touch heel to toe on several steps, she raised her arms above 6 inches to regain her balance, she completed 11 steps instead of 9, without counting each step out loud, and she turned incorrectly. On the next 9 steps, she was unable to touch heel to toe on several steps, raised her arms above 6 inches for balance, counted each step incorrectly, and only completed 8 steps.

The next test explained was the One Leg Stand Test. Johnston was asked if she felt alright, and if her legs or back were bothering her, or if she had any injuries she did not disclose earlier, which she replied "I'm fine." I explained the test to Johnston, and asked if she understood the instructions, which she stated she did. She was instructed to begin the test, and raised her right foot approximately 6 inches from the sidewalk and was able to keep her foot flat. When counting, Johnston raised her arms above 6 inches for balance, and when reaching "one-thousand nine", she put her foot down. She raised her foot again, and continued counting. She was swaying while balancing and was instructed to put her foot down.

Johnston was taken into custody. She was handcuffed (double-locked), searched and seat belted in the rear passenger seat of marked patrol vehicle #38. Johnston began crying and stated she was not operating the vehicle when the airbags deployed, and only told me she was driving to save her boyfriend from being in trouble. When Ptl. DeLuca initially arrived on-scene, Johnston was exiting the vehicle from the driver's door, and while speaking with me initially, she admitted to driving and never entering the home prior to police arrival. Also, she had the vehicle keys in her possession, which she pulled from her pocket prior to performing the field sobriety tests. I removed the keys from her front pocket when searching her incident to arrest, and left them on the front seat of the vehicle she was operating. It should be noted that when I opened the driver's door of the vehicle, the driver's seat was positioned closely to the steering wheel, consistent with Johnston's height, and her personal belongings (wallet and cell phone) were on the driver's seat and the floor in front of the driver's seat. Additionally, after looking closer at the abrasion on her forehead, it appeared to be more of a rug-burn, and not a laceration. The head liner above the driver's seat, slightly above the windshield, had a small blood mark and flakes of what appeared to be skin in the same area, consistent with the injury on Johnston's head. The side curtain airbags were all deployed, the passenger side mirror was broken and the front passenger wheel was significantly damaged. The tire was flat and the rim had numerous large gauges in it. There was a large area of rubber flakes in the roadway, slightly ahead of the damaged wheel, and the sidewall of the tire was worn through, consistent with the vehicle attempting to be driven. The vehicle was parked in front of the driveway of 365 Elm Ln., facing the wrong direction of traffic.

Sgt. Thomas responded to the area which Johnston stated the motor vehicle crash occurred, and observed damage consistent with Johnston's report of the crash. (See NJTR-1 Report by Ptl. Nixon) Johnston was transported to Headquarters for processing. While transporting her, the passenger compartment of my patrol vehicle began filling with an odor of alcoholic beverage, which was coming from the rear of the vehicle.

On arrival at Headquarters, Johnston became agitated and belligerent. She was escorted to the cell block and while walking stated "if I hadn't had one drink or two drinks the results would be the same". Johnston was secured in a prisoner belt and was escorted to the booking room. She was advised of her Miranda Warning at 0005 hours on 2/28/19, and refused to sign the form. I read the NJ Standard Statement and Johnston's reply to submitting breath samples was "No, absolutely fucking not". The additional statement was read and Johnston's reply was "absolutely fucking not". The Drinking Driver Questionnaire was completed, and Johnston refused to answer any questions about what alcoholic drinks she consumed or how many. A copy of the Drinking Driver Questionnaire was included with Johnston's personal belongings. She became very antagonistic and was placed into a cell, where she continued to be belligerent.

Contacted Dispatch and informed them he arranged for a ride for Johnston. Johnston became irate and demanded a phone call for a ride, which I informed her was already on their way.

Liability Form and signed the acknowledgement or receipt at 0217 hours. was provided the original copy of the form and a photocopy was included with this report. The vehicle Johnston operated was towed by Lepore's Towing per John's Law. Johnston was issued the following motor vehicle Summonses: E19-820 for DUI 39:4-50; E19-821 for Consent to Take Breath Samples 39:4-50.2, E19-822 for Refusal to Submit to Chemical Test (penalties) 39:4-50.4A, E19-823 for Reckless Driving 39:4-96, E19-824 for Failure to Wear Seatbelt 39:3-76.2f, E19-825 for Failure to Possess Driver's License 39:3-29A, and E19-826 for Parking-Direction of Vehicle 39:4-135.
